**Libraries**: The libraries at Amity are more like Integrated Knowledge Resource Centres that are stocked with more than 30542 books 90 Journals, 26 Magazines. Periodicals, references, national and international journals covering all aspects of academic studies and research materials. Besides a huge Central Library, the University also has five Departmental Libraries for Engineering, Management, Law, Architecture and Psychology. We have over 20,000 online journals. Amity has the membership of MANUPATRA, DELNET, Sodh Ganga and National Digital Library (NDL), World e-book Library, South Asia Archive. All Amity students are members of Amizone-Amity Intranet Zone which allows them easy access to these journals & papers.

One in each academic block, which serves hot, hygienic and good quality food at highly subsidized rates. The cafeteria makes a vibrant & informal meeting place for the students where friendships for a life time are nurtured. The quality of the food is monitored on a regular basis by a committee comprising university officials and students.



<u>Auditorium</u>: A State-of-the-art auditoriums with a combined seating capacity of over 600 acts as a common ground for students, faculty and corporate personalities for regular interfaces, conferences and other events. These auditorium facilitates in bringing students face to face with global thought leaders, academic gurus and corporate heads to share their experiences.



**Seminar Halls:** Amity has 02 Seminar Hall with a seating capacity of 300 each. Extremely well designed, the Seminar Halls have all the audio-visual facilities for conducting seminars, conferences and guest lecturers for a large gathering of students.



**<u>Conference Halls</u>**: There are 02 Conference Halls in the University, one each in Academic Blocks A & B. These conference halls are equipped with audio-visual aids and can be used for video/audio conferencing as well as presentations.



**Moot Court:** Amity has a State of the Art Moot Court which is constantly engaged in providing a hands on learning experience to the students of Law.







Additionally, telephones with networking facility to connect to other Amity Universities and Delhi Office have also been provided. A dedicated bandwidth of 210 MBPS is available. Out of which 4 MBPS is dedicated for video conferencing.





**Studio Type Accommodation for Faculty**: Amity provides studio type accommodations to its faculty and staff. 10 such well furnished studio apartments are available in the campus.



<u>Stationary Shop</u>: AUMP also has a stationary shop in its campus and is managed by contractor. Students/faculty members/Staff can avail the facility during the working hours.

Apart from the stationary items it also facilitates photocopy (both color and black & white), Scanning, Printing, lamination and Internet facilities.



**ATM (Automated Teller Machine):** In order to facilitate the students, staff of Amity University ATM Facility is available at prime location in the university campus.

# <u>Hostels</u>

The University has three large hostels two for boys and one for girls with capacity of 240 each totaling to 720. Separate facilities for boys and girls, caring wardens, and tight security ensure a pleasant stay for students. The mantra of Amity hostel staff is to create a home away from home for all hostel students.



This is achieved by ensuring 24 hours power and water supply, clean, well-lit, specious rooms, common rooms with television, geysers in bathrooms, and window with wire mesh to keep out mosquitoes. Each student is provided with a separate bed, mattress, pillow and study table. Each hostel is surrounded by a boundary wall and entry to the hostel is restricted to only those students who are staying in hostel. The hostellers are required to show their identity cards to the security personnel posted at hostel gates and also sign their entry using bio-metric device installed in each hostel.



All hostels are Wi-Fi enabled, and the students can access the net 24/7 from their rooms. The students are provided a free laundry service, and have 24 hours access to the Medical Room.

<u>Medical Facility</u>: The medical room is located within the hostel so that the students can easily avail medical care. For emergencies and major medical problems an ambulance is available to ferry the sick to multi specialty hospitals. We also have a male as well as female Medical Assistant for boys and girls respectively.



**Laundry Facility**: The washed and ironed linen is made available within 48 hours. This is a free facility for all inmates of Amity hostels.

## **GREEN INITIATIVE**

With an aim to promote clean and green energy, the University has successfully installed roof top solar panels in its 03 Academic Blocks with a total capacity of 305 KW. Through this initiative total savings of Rs. 26,48,812/- (rupees twenty six lakhs forty eight thousand eight hundred twelve) has been done for the period between July, 2018 to June 2019 in the energy consumption of the University. The electricity bill has been reduced to approximately 10% per month of the total bill amount.







## a) Gender Wise Strength of Students Admitted in 2019-20: (Total)


## (b) Total Gender Wise Strength of Students (Total: 2019)



The compensation level received by B.Tech students has gone up nearly by 47% this year as far as highest package is concerned. Last Year highest annual CTC was 7.50 Lac and this year it is 11.00 Lac PA

As far as average Annual CTC Package of ASET Department as a whole is concerned, the package has improved by 21.10 % compared that of last year. Last year Average CTC was 3.17 Lac and this year average CTC is 3.97 Lac PA

So far 90.00% of the final year students have been placed.

With 15-18 more companies in pipeline for Mechanical, Biotechnology, Mass Communication and CIVIL engineering, AU MP is on Track to Achieve 100% Placement for 2020 Graduating Batch.



- Performance Based Annual Increment. In Amity University Madhya Pradesh, performance based annual increments are given to all the staff and faculty members. Percentage of increment to the faculties are linked to their Annual Performance Indicator (API plus) and their overall performance and in respect of other employees, it is performance based on written recommendations of their HoIs/HoDs.
- 2. <u>Financial Assistance for Attending Seminars/ Conferences/Workshops.</u> Faculty members are provided financial assistance for attending the national and international conferences/seminars/workshops in accordance with University policy. Members of faculty AUMP had been provided financial assistance for attending national and international seminars/workshops/conferences/FDP.
- 3. <u>Fee Concession and Special Increments for Ph.D.</u> 50% fee concessions are being provided to the faculty members who have registered for Ph.D. degree at AU MP. On successful completion of Ph.D., a faculty member is given two increments as an incentive. If the faculty member continues to serve in the University for a period of 3 years, after the completion of Ph.D. then the balance of 50% fee paid by him/her is also reimbursed.
- 4. <u>Medical Insurance for Staff and Faculty Members.</u> All the staffs and faculty members of AU MP are covered under Medical Insurance Scheme and the premium is paid by the University. Three renowened of Gwalior hospitals named RJN Spectra Superspeciality Hospital, BIMR Hospital, Govil Hospital, Kalyan Hospital and Shree Diagnostic have been associated with AUMP where cashless treatment is available to the employees of AUMP.
