Through its NSS Unit, Eco Club, the university conducts regular outreach programs, workshops, and demonstrations in nearby villages. These initiatives educate residents on rainwater harvesting, wastewater reuse, pollution prevention, and safe drinking water practices. Faculty and students from Environmental Science and Biotechnology departments lead hands-on training on low-cost water filtration and household conservation methods. Events like World Water Day, Swachhta Pakhwada, and Jal Shakti Abhiyan are observed annually with community participation.



The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of AUMP in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club, organised an impactful water conservation as well as HIV/AIDS awareness camp at Shigora village. Our student volunteers conducted workshops, engaging villagers with talks and quizzes to educate them about water conservation and sanitation.
