AUMP Collaboration with NGOs for SDGs

Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP) demonstrates a sustained commitment to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through diverse academic, co-curricular, and community outreach initiatives. The institution has undertaken several programs reflecting active student volunteering, NGO collaborations, research-based initiatives, and faculty-led educational resource development. These activities are strategically aligned with multiple SDGs, particularly SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being), SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 5 (Gender Equality), SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure), SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities), SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production), SDG 13 (Climate Action), and SDG 15 (Life on Land). Collectively, these undertakings illustrate the university's integrated approach to sustainable development through knowledge dissemination, skill enhancement, and social engagement.

The **World Environment Day 2024 Celebration**, organized by the Department of Environmental Science in collaboration with the Eco-Club and the Centre of Excellence for Biodiversity and Environmental Conservation, exemplified AUMP's commitment to environmental stewardship. The event, themed "*Land Restoration, Desertification, and Drought Resilience – Our Land, Our Future,*" encouraged 211 students to participate in poster and slogan competitions that promoted awareness of ecological challenges. Similarly, the **Earth Day 2024 Celebration** by Amity Business School fostered environmental responsibility and creativity through poster making and slogan writing activities, emphasizing reduction in plastic use and conservation of natural resources. Both initiatives, aligned with SDGs 13 and 15, contributed to strengthening environmental consciousness among youth.

Promoting health and holistic well-being, the **Two-Day National Level Lecture Programme on "Green Yoga and the Art of Living with Nature"** (July 2023), funded by the Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR), Ministry of Education, Government of India, reinforced the physical, mental, and spiritual dimensions of health. The programme integrated academic deliberations and practical yoga sessions to highlight the symbiotic relationship between human wellness and ecological

balance. Complementing this, **World Pharmacist Day 2023** was celebrated by the Amity Institute of Pharmacy under the theme “*Pharmacy Strengthening Health Systems – Angdaan Mahadan.*” Activities such as community health check-up camps, medicinal tree plantations, and awareness campaigns underscored pharmacists’ roles in public health and responsible healthcare delivery, aligning directly with SDG 3.

A significant social outreach initiative, “**One Hour Smile,**” conducted in partnership with Aadar Foundation, focused on supporting homeless and unclaimed elderly citizens. Through this initiative, students and faculty members from Amity Business School distributed nutritious food and interacted with beneficiaries, demonstrating compassion, empathy, and social responsibility. Similarly, the **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Awareness Program**, held under the guidance of medical experts and following Pharmacy Council of India guidelines, trained students and staff in lifesaving CPR techniques. These health-oriented activities promoted practical knowledge and preparedness for medical emergencies, further contributing to SDG 3.

On the academic front, AUMP organized the **Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Indian Knowledge System (IKS)** in July 2023 through its Directorate of Research and Publication. The FDP brought together eminent experts to explore Indian perspectives on sustainability, culture, and science, emphasizing interconnectedness between traditional wisdom and modern disciplines. The sessions, aligning with SDGs 4, 9, and 12, encouraged faculty to integrate indigenous knowledge into pedagogy and research. In continuation, the **Expert Talk and Workshop on Soft Skills Training for Professionals** (November 2023) and the **Two-Day Capacity Development and Skill Enhancement Programme** (February 2024) focused on strengthening employability skills. These initiatives enhanced students’ competencies in communication, teamwork, and digital literacy, thereby supporting SDG 8 and SDG 9 objectives of capacity development and inclusive growth.

Educational resource development and teacher training also remained a major thrust area. The **Faculty Development Programme on “Implementing Holistic Learning Approaches in Primary Education: A Roadmap for Teachers under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020”** provided educators with a comprehensive understanding of experiential learning, flexibility in subject choice, and vocational integration in school education. The session, conducted by Amity Business School faculty, enhanced awareness regarding NEP 2020 reforms and promoted student-centric pedagogy, aligning with SDG 4 (Quality Education). The **Workshop on “Bhartiya Gayan Parampara: Vividh Sandharbh – Indian Knowledge System Manovigyan”**, conducted by the Amity Institute of Behavioural and Allied Sciences (AIBAS), emphasized the relevance of ancient Indian philosophical traditions to modern psychology and human behaviour. By bridging traditional wisdom with contemporary education, the university strengthened its role in preserving and applying cultural knowledge systems for holistic learning.

In the field of community health and gender equity, AUMP organized the **Cancer Awareness Workshop** in collaboration with the Cancer Hospital and Research Institute, Gwalior, sensitizing students and faculty to early detection and prevention of cancer. The interactive sessions on breast, cervical, and head-and-neck cancers highlighted the significance of regular screening, HPV vaccination, and mental

resilience in coping with chronic illness. Aligned with SDGs 3 and 5, this initiative reflected a strong integration of medical awareness and mental health education. Similarly, the **Session on Female Health and Hygiene** held in September 2023 educated young women on menstrual hygiene, reproductive health, and emotional well-being. Experts from the field addressed misconceptions, encouraged dialogue, and advocated for inclusive health education, further advancing the SDG 5 goal of gender equality.

To promote youth empowerment and career readiness, the **Career Counselling Workshop under the Vidyanjali Initiative** was organized for government school students to support informed decision-making and skill planning. The workshop guided participants in career goal setting, higher education options, and personal development, contributing to SDG 4 and SDG 8. Additionally, the **Poster Making Competition on “Mobile Addiction – Use and Abuse”**, organized during Innovation Week 2023, inspired students to analyze the behavioral impacts of excessive mobile use and propose responsible technology practices, thereby aligning with SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being) and SDG 4 (Quality Education).

Overall, the events and programs under *Indicator 17.2.5* demonstrate AUMP’s institutional integration of sustainability into academic operations, community engagement, and professional training. The university’s partnerships with NGOs, industry experts, and government bodies amplify the impact of these initiatives, creating a model of collaborative development that merges theoretical understanding with practical implementation. Each activity, whether in environmental conservation, health promotion, educational innovation, or social outreach, underscores the university’s holistic approach toward achieving the SDGs through education, research, and responsible citizenship.

Through these sustained endeavors, AUMP has embedded SDG principles into its educational and administrative ecosystem, transforming its campus into a center for sustainable learning and community empowerment. By fostering a culture of social responsibility, ecological awareness, and ethical conduct among students and faculty, the university actively contributes to the national and global vision of sustainable and inclusive development. The comprehensive range of programs conducted during 2023–24 thus reaffirms Amity University Madhya Pradesh’s role as a leading higher education institution committed to promoting *Education for Sustainable Development* and translating the spirit of “*Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam*”—the world is one family—into tangible, community-oriented outcomes.

On 14 September 2023, Amity Institute of Behavioral and Allied Sciences, Amity University Madhya Pradesh, organized a session on Female Health and Hygiene for 90 students and 7 faculty members from AIBAS, AISS, and ASAP. The session aimed to educate female students about menstrual hygiene, reproductive health, and the connection between menstrual and mental health.

Experts Dr. Namita Agarwal and Dr. Veera Lohia explained the menstrual cycle, phases, hygiene practices, myths, and the role of yoga in alleviating menstrual pain. They also addressed female mental health, including stress, anxiety, depression, and the importance of counseling, social support, and professional help. Students raised queries on menstrual products, fertility, and safe sexual practices, which were addressed by the experts.
