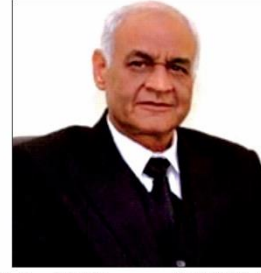

## ESTABLISHMENT OF AMITY UNIVERSITY MADHYA PRADESH

### About AUMP

1. Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP) was established by RitnandBalved Education Foundation (RBEF) at Gwalior by Madhya Pradesh NijiVishwavidyalaya (SthapnaAvamSanchalan) Adhinyam – 2007 and Dwitiya SanshodhanAdhinyam (No. 27 of 2010) vide State Government Notification No. 7692-402 -□□□□□□ - □ - (□□□□) dated 30 Dec 2010, with the view to promote professional, industry-oriented education in the state of Madhya Pradesh. Amity University Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior located on a sprawling campus of 102 acres of land opposite Gwalior Airport, imparts modern, practical and research-oriented courses which lead to the development of professionals who are employable and industry ready. This in turn drives the socio-economic upliftment of the region.
2. Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP) imparts education in almost all areas including management, engineering, architecture, biotechnology, law, Journalism & mass communication, behavioral science, Psychology, fashion, Political Science, Pharmacy etc.

**Class Rooms:** Amity University Madhya Pradesh has 55 class rooms. All classrooms are spacious and air-conditioned. They provide the most conducive atmosphere for dynamic and focused discussions. Class rooms at Amity have been designed to bring together teaching with discussion & analysis and are augmented with integrated audio-visual teaching aids for lectures presentations etc.

**Lecture Theaters:** Amity University Madhya Pradesh has 32 air-conditioned Lecture Theatres. These lecture theatres not only cater to the need of larger classes, but are structured to facilitate student seminars, project presentations etc.

**Laboratories:** Amity University Madhya Pradesh provides students with a wealth of hands-on learning opportunities. There are more than 40 laboratories where students can get first-hand learning experience in different areas like Mechanical, Electronics, Information Technology, Welding, Construction, Biotechnology, Fashion, Design, Communication Skills, Photography, Pharmacy etc.

**Computer Laboratories:** Amity University has 11 computer labs with more than 500 computers with latest configurations. All computer labs are well maintained by a dedicated IT staff and have latest hardware and licensed softwares available on the system. The softwares take care of the needs of all the students. As an ongoing process, these labs are upgraded regularly with software as per syllabi of the students.

**Libraries:** The libraries at Amity are more like Integrated Knowledge Resource Centers that are stocked with more than 32507 books 96 Journals. Periodicals, references, national and international journals covering all aspects of academic studies and research materials. Besides a huge Central Library, the University also has five Departmental Libraries for Engineering, Management, Law, Architecture and Psychology. We have over 4,00,000e-Journals, e-books, e-Magazines etc. Amity has the membership of All India Reporter (AIR), DELNET, Shodhganga and National Digital Library (NDL), World e-book Library, South Asia Archive. All Amity students are members of Amizone-Amity Intranet Zone which allows them easy access to these Journals & papers.

## Hostels

The University has three large hostels two for boys and one for girls with capacity of 240 each totaling to 720. Separate facilities for boys and girls, caring wardens, and tight security ensure a pleasant stay for students. The mantra of Amity hostel staff is to create a home away from home for all hostel students.



This is achieved by ensuring 24 hours power and water supply, clean, well-lit, spacious rooms, common rooms with television, geysers in bathrooms, and window with wire mesh to keep out mosquitoes. Each student is provided with a separate bed, mattress, pillow and study table. Each hostel is surrounded by a boundary wall and entry to the hostel is restricted to only those students who are staying in hostel. The hostellers are required to show their identity cards to the security personnel posted at hostel gates and also sign their entry using bio-metric device installed in each hostel.

All hostels are Wi-Fi enabled, and the students can access the net 24/7 from their rooms. The students are provided a free laundry service and have 24 hours access to the Medical Room.

**Cafeterias:** Besides a student Mess located in the hostels, the University has 04 cafeterias and 01 Milk Parler. One in each academic block, which serves hot, hygienic and good quality food at highly subsidized rates. The cafeteria makes a vibrant & informal meeting place for the students where friendships for a life time are nurtured. The quality of the food is monitored on a regular basis by a committee comprising university officials and students.



**Auditorium:** A State-of-the-art auditoriums with a combined seating capacity of over 600 acts as a common ground for students, faculty and corporate personalities for regular interfaces, conferences and other events. These auditorium facilitates in bringing students face to face with global thought leaders, academic gurus and corporate heads to share their experiences.



**Seminar Halls:** Amity has 02 Seminar Hall with a seating capacity of 300 each. Extremely well designed, the Seminar Halls have all the audio-visual facilities for conducting seminars, conferences and guest lecturers for a large gathering of students.



**Conference Halls:** There are 02 Conference Halls in the University, one each in Academic Blocks A & B. These conference halls are equipped with audio-visual aids and can be used for video/audio conferencing as well as presentations.





**Moot Court:** Amity has a state of the art moot court which is constantly engaged in providing a hands on learning experience to the students of Law.

**Studio:** Amity School of Communication has a state of art Studio which has no parallel in the entire state of M.P. The large sound proof studio is designed to facilitate video/audio recording and shooting.

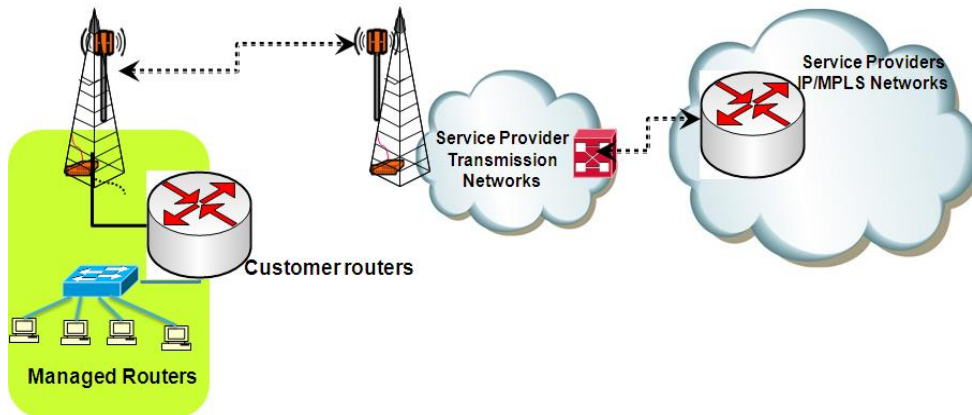

## GREEN INITIATIVE

With an aim to promote clean and green energy, the University has successfully installed roof top solar panels in its 03 Academic Blocks with a total capacity of 305 KW. Through this initiative total savings of Rs. 26,48,812/- (rupees twentysix lakhs forty eight thousand eight hundred twelve) has been done for the period between July, 2020 to June 2021 in the energy consumption of the University. The electricity bill has been reduced to approximately 10% per month of the total bill amount.

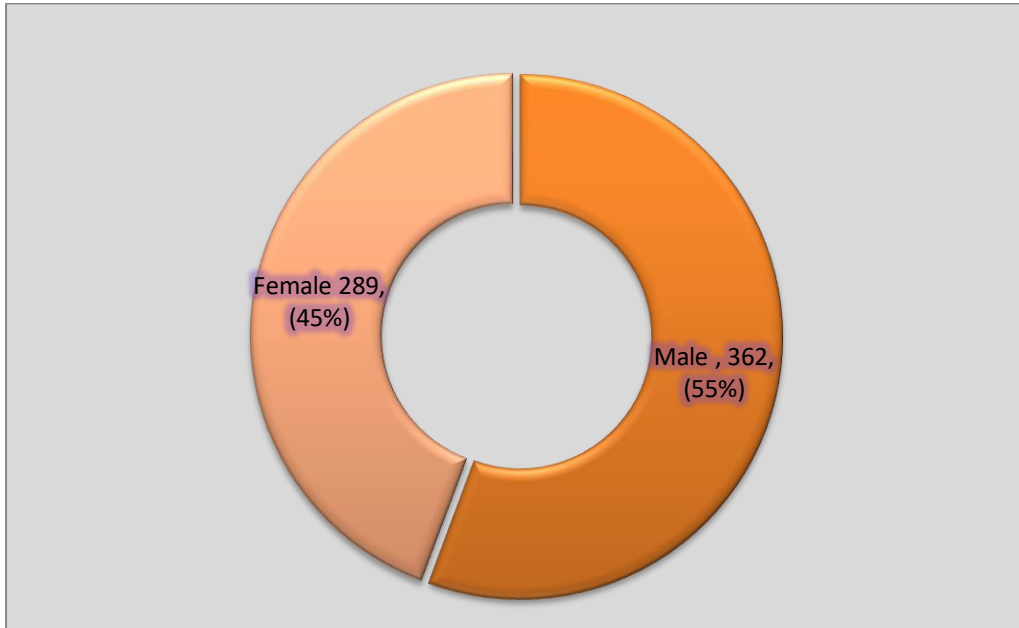

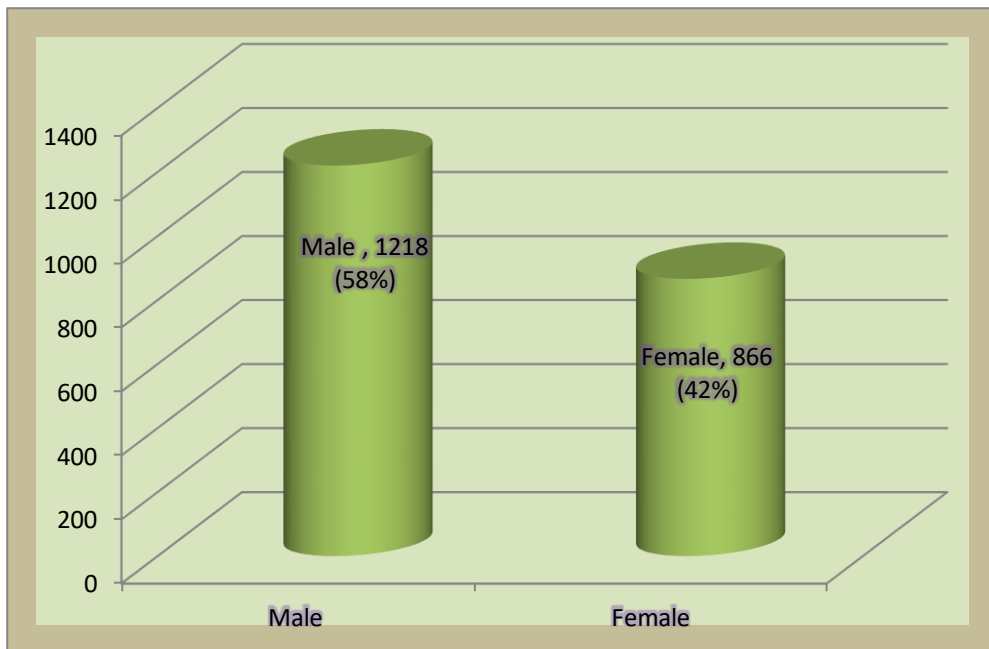

**(b) Total Gender Wise Strength of Students (Total: 2020-21)**

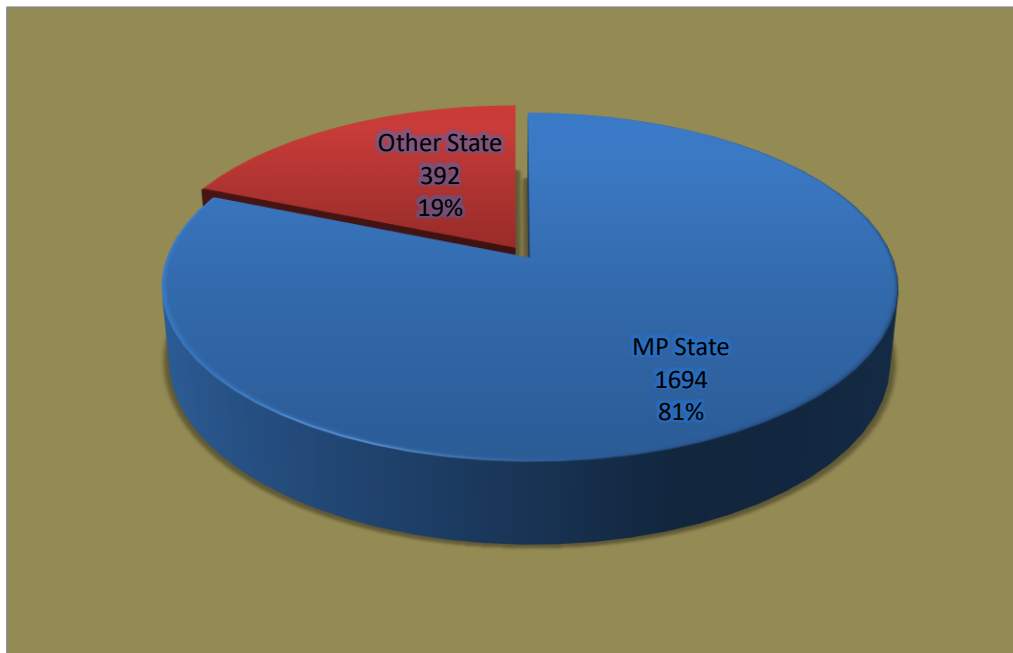




**c) State Wise Strength of Students Admitted in 2020-21**

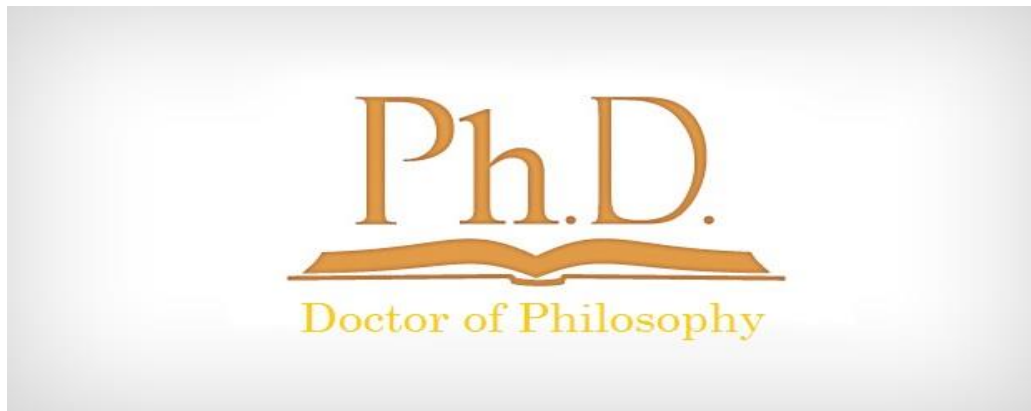

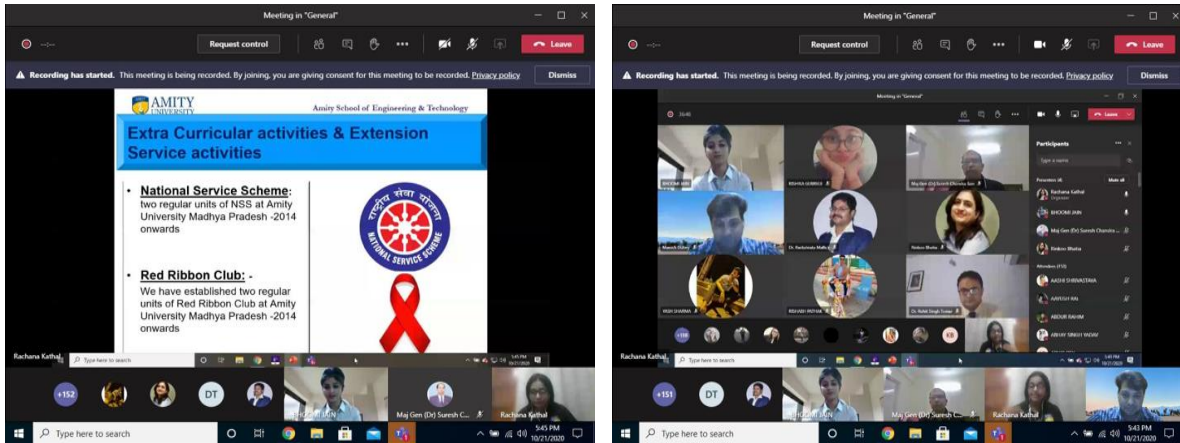

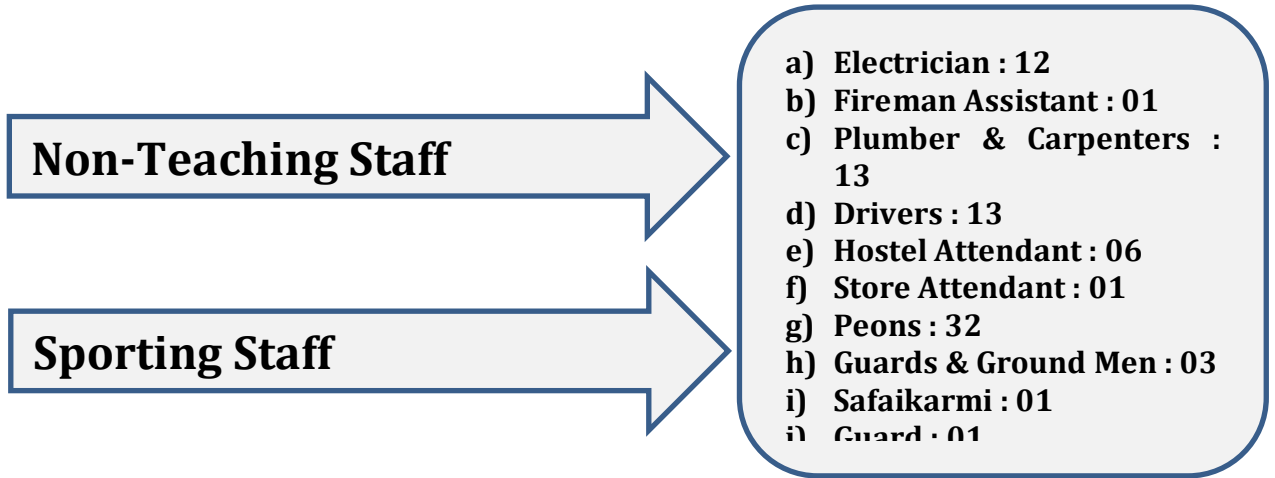

## **INCENTIVES FOR FACULTY MEMBERS & STAFF**

1. **Performance Based Annual Increment.**In Amity University Madhya Pradesh, performance based annual increments are given to all the staff and faculty members. Percentage of increment to the faculties are linked to their Annual Performance Indicator (API plus) and their overall performance and in respect of other employees, it is performance based on written recommendations of their Hols/HoDs.
2. **Financial Assistance for Attending Seminars/ Conferences/Workshops.**Faculty members are provided financial assistance for attending the national and international conferences/seminars/workshops in accordance with University policy. Members of faculty AUMP had been provided financial assistance for attending national and international seminars/workshops/conferences/FDP.
3. **Fee Concession and Special Increments for Ph.D.**50% fee concessions are being provided to the faculty members who have registered for Ph.D. degree at AU MP. On successful completion of Ph.D., a faculty member is given two increments as an incentive. If the faculty member continues to serve in the University for a period of 3years, after the completion of Ph.D. then the balance of 50% fee paid by him/her is also reimbursed.
4. **Medical Insurance for Staff and Faculty Members.**All the staffs and faculty members of AU MP are covered under Medical Insurance Scheme and the premium is paid by the University. Threerenowned of Gwalior hospitals named RJN Spectra Superspeciality Hospital, BIMR Hospital, Govil Hospital, Kalyan Hospitaland Shree Diagnostic have been associated with AUMP where cashless treatment is available to the employees of AUMP.
