Even so much hard work and effort may fail to get your business off the ground. In such a case, boot camps could come to the rescue. Boot camps for start-ups help budding entrepreneurs in understanding the nuances of entrepreneurship, acquiring necessary skills to write a business proposal and skills to effectively pitch. Boot camp is a space for budding entrepreneurs to meet others who are in the same boat as they are and learn from each other's experiences. It serves as a platform to learn, interact and get direct feedback from industry experts, start-up gurus, mentors and topnotch academicians. It offers a great networking opportunity. It is no doubt a challenging space, and you can expect tough questions and endless hours of preparation and activities. But at the end of it, you will have gained clarity, learned the necessary skills, received critical inputs and become stronger.

### **Purpose:**

The sole purpose of Bootcamp is to teach how to develop a pitch deck and to take a hard look at financial needs and prospects. It's also a chance to address the shortcomings in your idea and develop answers to the tough questions anyone would ask before venturing with financials.

### **Duration:**

Five-Six days of the intensive knowledge sharing session, followed by the marathon mentoring clinic along with demo pitching session followed by Networking with stakeholders & Speed Dating with Investors.
