BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

The NSS Cell of Amity University Rajasthan, in collaboration with **Santokaba Durlabji Memorial Hospital** and supported by **HDFC Bank**, organized a **Blood Donation Drive** on **September 27, 2024**. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from the university community, *embodying the spirit of generosity and solidarity*. The drive commenced with a warm welcome by **Dr. Manoj Kumar** and **Dr. Pallavi Mishra**, followed by an inspiring address from **Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Amit Jain**.

SWACCHTA HI SEVA DRIVE

The NSS Cell of Amity University Rajasthan conducted a cleanliness drive in Achrol village under the **Swachhata Hi Seva** initiative, launched by the **Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports**. The campaign aimed to *raise awareness about cleanliness and sustainable sanitation in rural areas*. **Dr. Manoj Kumar** welcomed the villagers and **Sarpanch representative Mr. Sardar Mal Saini**, who motivated volunteers. **University Registrar Dr. Nitin Bhardwaj** expressed gratitude to the representative of the Sarpanch and villagers while applauded the NSS volunteers. **Prof. Parul Mishra, Mr. Kapil Dangi, and Mr. Vinod Kumar Sharma** also played active role in the event.



Volunteers, divided into groups of fives, collected at least 2 kg of *recyclable plastic*, making the activity both engaging and impactful.
