

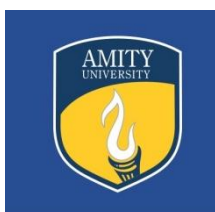

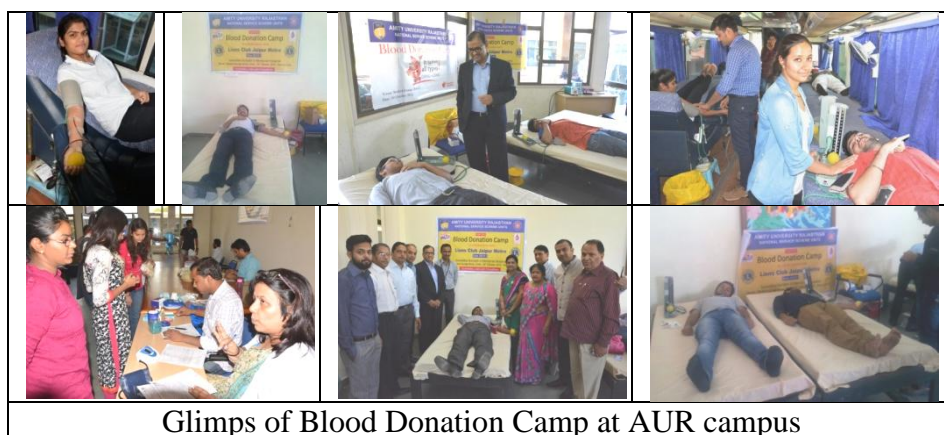
Blood Donation Camp

NSS Trip to Virat Nagar

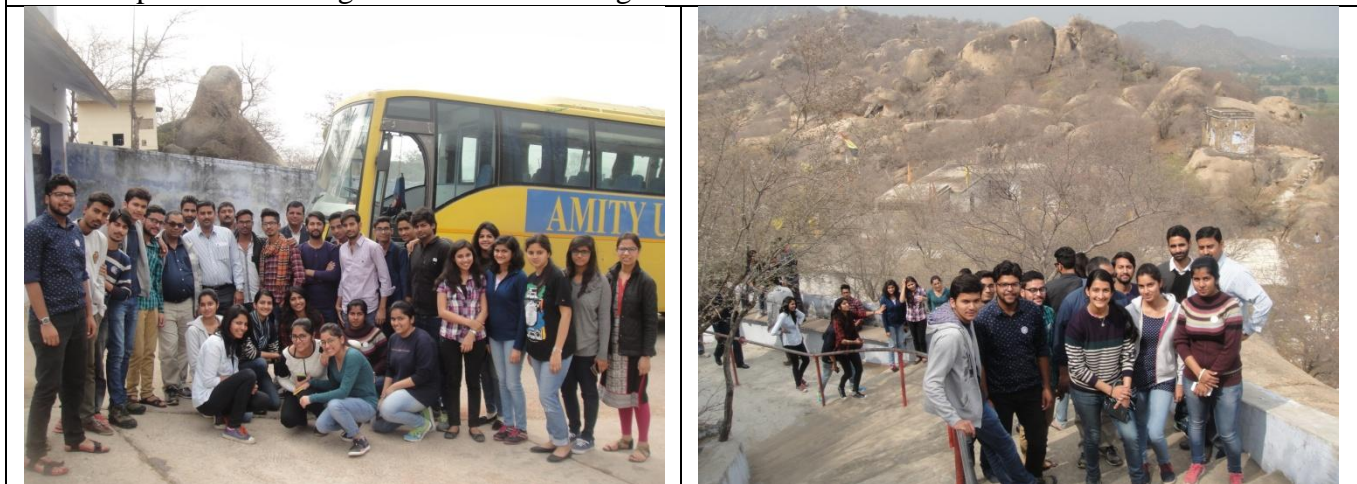

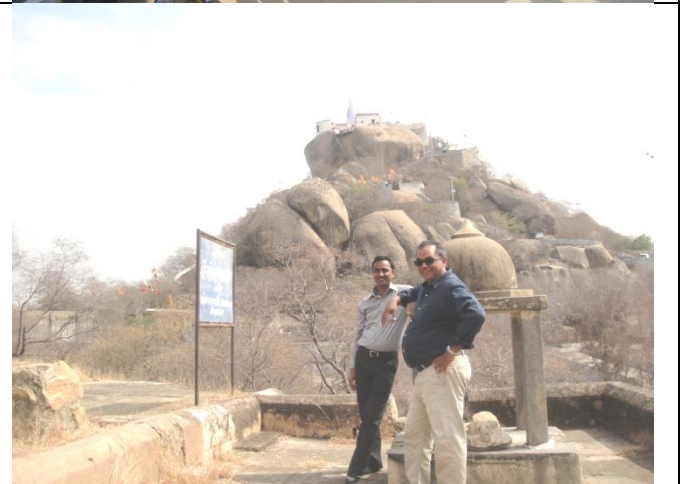
