## Lecture on cyber security

On 25<sup>th</sup> of April, 2018 a lecture was delivered by Dr. Mudit Chaturvedi, Expert of cyber security from Jaipur. He was introduced by Dr. Prashant Mishra, NSS officer to the audience in presence of Dr. Manoj Kumar and Dr. Ratandeep Roy.

Dr. Chaturvedi explained the cyber crimes. He tried to define the cyber crime. He discussed all social media like facebook, watsapp, instagram etc and related unintentional cyber crimes. How we can save ourselves from being victim of unauthentic banking transactions. He also mentioned several live examples where cyber crime happened and how the culprit was caught with evidences.

He told the volunteers that we should block our sim card properly by intimating the service provider, if we are not using a phone or we want to change the number otherwise our sim can be misused for bank transaction and other unwanted purpose.

Similarly he told that group admin remains always responsible for group activities on social network, so we must be cautious.

He also told that as soon as we are victimized by cyber crimes we must inform police and lodge FIR and block our bank account if unwanted transactions have happened, even a transaction of one rupee has happened.

Students were enthuastic and asked few more questions like how can we ensure safety while using social networks.

#### Traffic awareness and safe driving workshop

#### A Doctor's Talk on kidney stones

As a part of the special camp of NSS a doctor's talk was organized for NSS volunteers and interested other students and faculty members on 26 April, 2018. Dr. Narinder Singh, Assistant Professor from National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur delivered the talk. Dr. Manoj Kumar has been the coordinator of this event. Dr. Singh discussed the structure of the kidney and the process of formation of the stone. He explained that dehydration and lesser intake of water and improper diet may be reason of stone formation besides genetic and metabolic disorders. We cannot manage genetic and metabolic disorders, however certainly we can change our life style to reduce the chances of kidney stone formation.

He discussed that need of surgery depends on location, size and nature of the stone in the kidney. Many a times there is no need of surgery and we can remove the stone using ayurvedic or allopathic treatment. He told that stone formation is a recurring process and there are chances that it will form again if removed once. In that case the individual must take care of his/her diet and water intake.

During discussion, students and faculties asked many questions related to stone and ayurveda to Dr. Singh. Dr. Singh satisfied the audience. During this talk Brig (Retd) G S Rathore, Dr. Ratandeep Roy, Dr. Vinod Singh Gour, Mr. Anjani K Shukla, Dr. Prashant, Dr, Kumar Sambhav Verma, Dr, Amit Khandelwal, Dr. Naveen were present. Brig Rathore presented vote of thanks and motivated students to join NSS for the cause of Nation development.
