




Pledge for COVID Awareness




National Youth Day


Dr. Manoj Kumar, Coordinator, NSS concluded the ceremony by urging the participants to inculcate the road safety


Women's Day Celebration on 9 March 2021






Stress Management Workshop






Cyber Security Awareness
