### *Message from the Pro-Vice Chancellor*



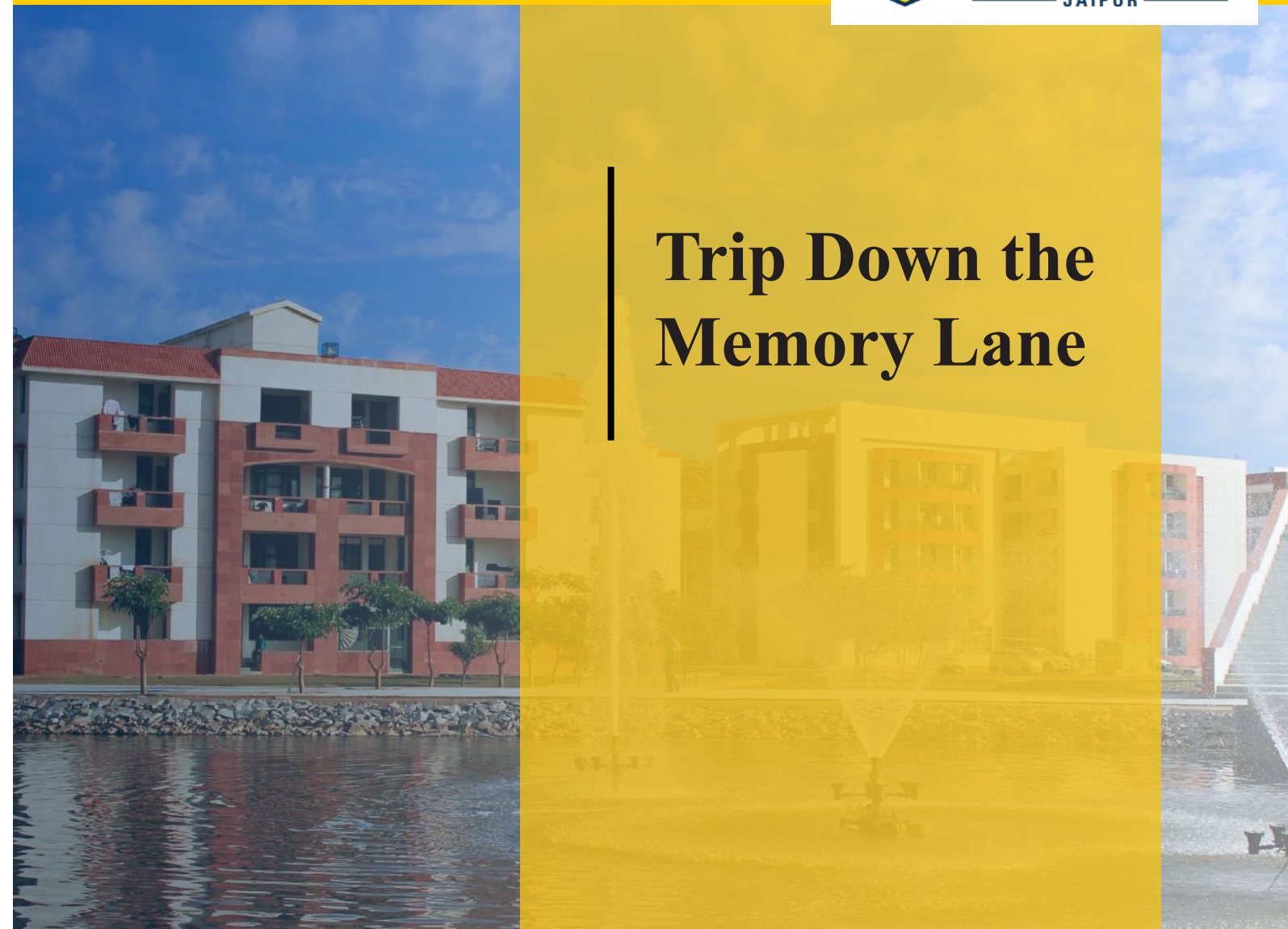

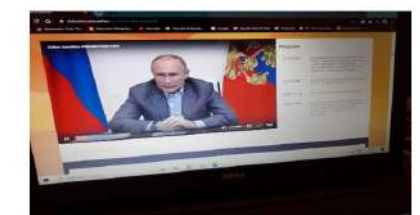






### Yakshita Sisodiya, NSS volunteer attends Online Marathon Programme dedicated to Volunteer Day by the Russian Federation

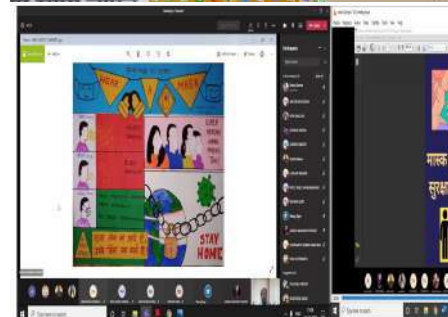


### Constitution Day Celebration

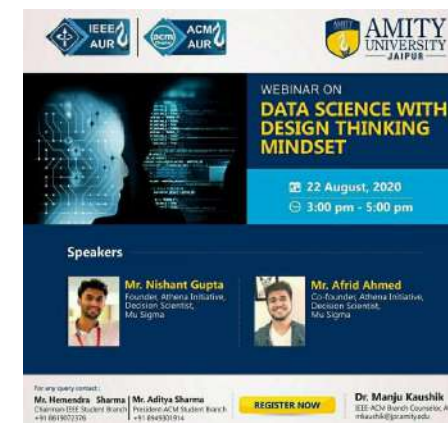

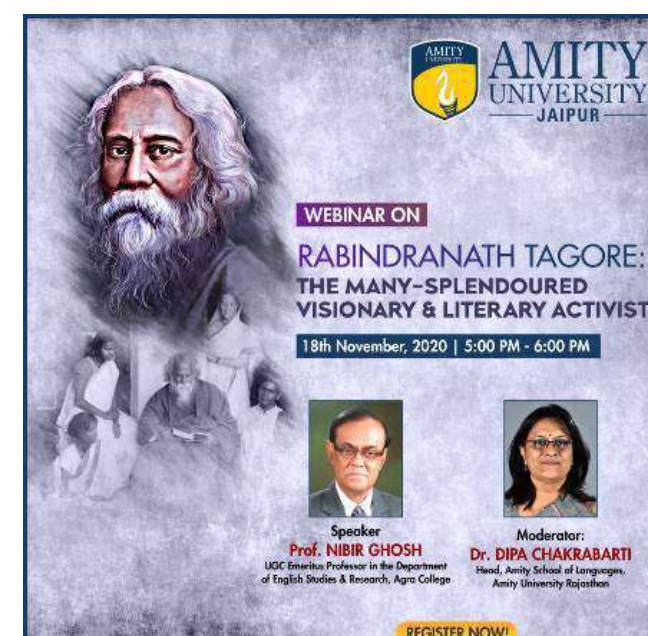
## Amity School of Languages

- An Alumni Meet event was conducted by Amity School of Languages on 31st October 2020.





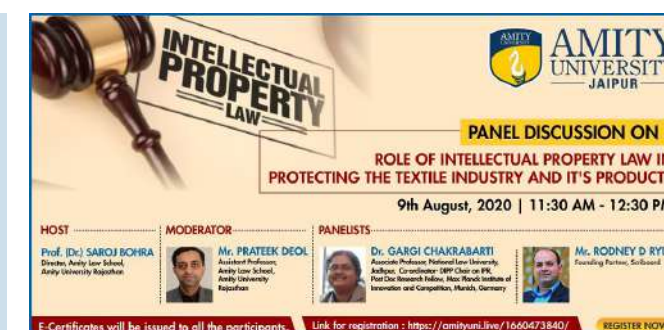
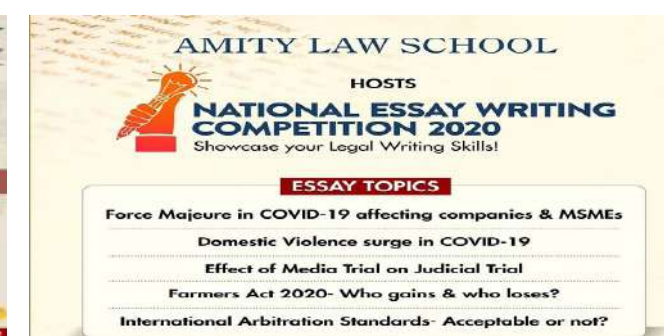
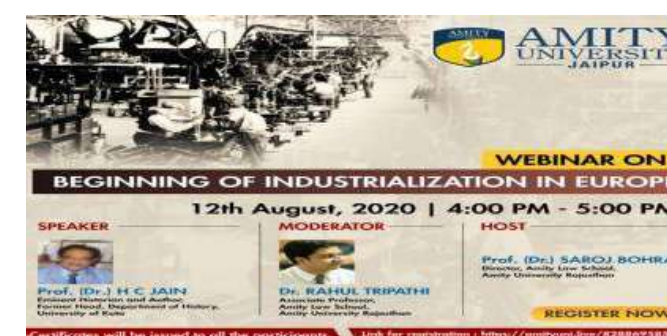

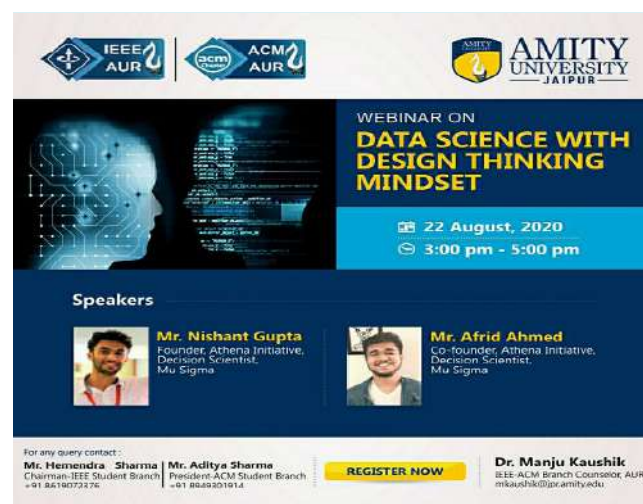
## Amity School of Architecture and Planning

### Post Pandemic Life Challenges

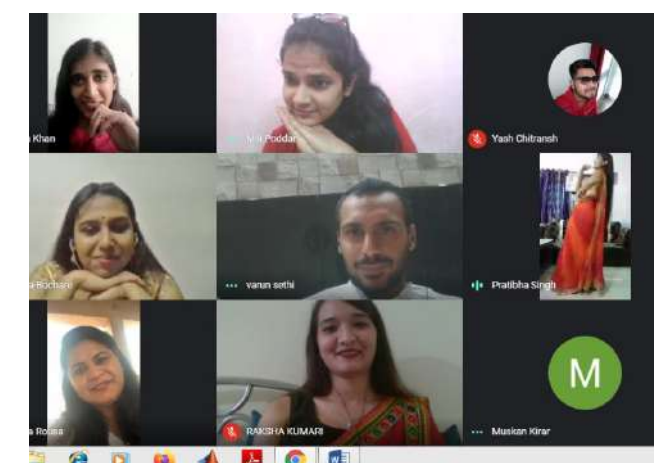

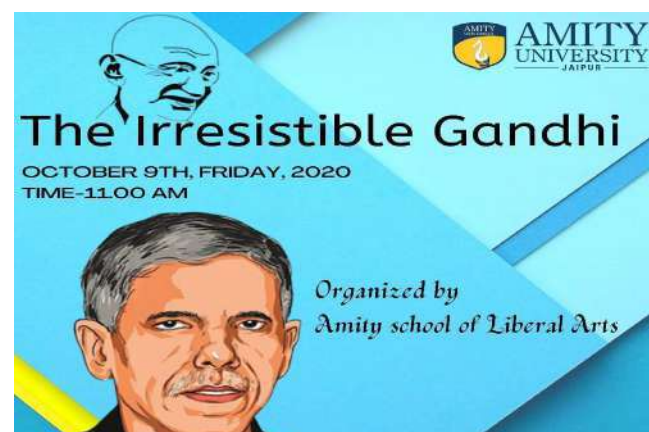
## Amity School of Fine Arts

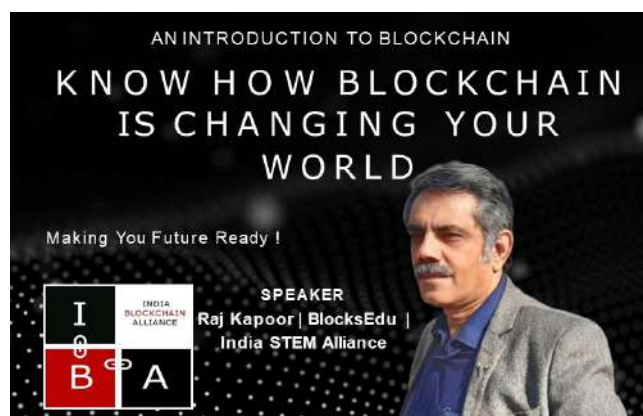
