With reference to your letter No. Nil dated 24th June, 2009 received in UGC office 29th June, 2009 on the above subject I am directed to inform you that Amity University, Rajasthan has been established by an Act of State Legislature of Rajasthan No. 8 of 2008, as a Private University and empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act at its main campus i.e. Rajasthan with the approval of Statutory Councils, wherever required.

Amity University, Rajasthan is not authorized to open study centre/off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State as per the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. Government of Chhattisgerh. The University can not open its centre even within the State as per the provision of UGC Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.

Inspection, by UGC as per the requirement of UGC Act, 1956 and Regulations (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 for ascertaining academic and physical infrastructure of a University is yet to be carried out in the case of Amity University, Rejasthan.

For starting Distance Education Programme if any, approval of Joint committee of UGC -AICTE-DEC is required. Approval letter for courses under distance mode should clearly state that the course has been approved by the Joint committee UGC-AICTE and DEC and the letter should be Jointly signed by Secretary UGC, Member Secretary, AICTE and Director DEC as per the provision laid down under clause 9 of the MOU signed by UGC-AICTE and DEC.

This is to bring to your kind knowledge that the following resolution was passed on 08th June, 2022 by the General Council of the Bar Council of India with respect to grant of provisional approval of affiliation for academic year 2022-2023 for those centers of Legal Education which have applied for approval of affiliation for the academic year 2022-2023.

"RESOLVED that with respect to existing Centers of Legal Education/colleges, whose inspection fee has been deposited, application for extension of approval of affiliation is pending, no inspection could be done or the inspection has been done, but inspection report could not be placed before the Legal Education Committee or the Standing Committee for its consideration, such Centers of Legal

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Education/colleges may continue to admit students only for the academic year 2022-2023. This will apply only in case where affiliation has been granted by the University, Such provisional approval shall be subject to any decision taken after the inspection of the CLE is done by the Bar Council of India subsequently.

It shall further be conditional and is subject to compliance as per circular dated 05.02.2020 bearing No.BCI:D:158 (LE:Circulation No.01/2020), issued to all Centers of Legal education, as per the extended time of such compliance which shall be 31st August, 2022, whereby every center of Legal Education/college shall be required to submit a certified authenticated bank statement bearing bank stamp, date and signature, mandatorily with respect to the salary/ies being disbursed to all the teachers/faculties every three months with effect from March, 2022 on a regular basis, unless specifically sought at other intervals, and also furnish list of teachers with qualifications as per BCI and UGC Rules, and further furnish proof/receipts of fulfilment of minimum library requirements, as enumerated under Schedule-III, Rule-15, Minimum Library requirements of Legal Education Rules-which is the sine qua non of a Center of Legal Education. Certain show cause notices and compliance letters had also been issued specifically to certain Centers of Legal Education/Colleges, with conditions mentioned therein, which have to be complied too as per the time stipulations therein, and if they have not been complied with they must be complied with immediately or latest by 31st August, 2022.

However, regardless of the date of 31st August, 2022 for compliance, an affidavit undertaking to comply with the conditions mentioned in the above referred circular and of all the rules of Legal Education, shall be required to be submitted by way of duly notarized affidavit within 15 days of receipt of this letter by way of hardcopy and also by way of scanned copy at complianceaffiliationle2@gmail.com with heading-COMPLIANCE TO PROVISIONAL APPROVAL-REQUIREMENTS

It is made clear that if any Center of Legal Education, fails to submit all the required documents as sought by way of the afore referred circular and the show cause notices (where applicable), and the compliance letters, already issued, by 31st August, 2022, then their application for extension of approval for 2022-2023 shall not be considered and, if, approval is granted for the academic session 2022-2023, it may be withdrawn too.

You may kindly bear in mind that the Bar Council of India is the sole and supreme sanctioning authority for seats and as a general rule it does not allow any supernumerary quota of seats for law degree courses, over and above the sanctioned strength of seats and whatever reservation of seats is to done by the University as a general rule has to be done within sanctioned strength of seats.

NORMS OF COUNCIL OF ARCHITECTURE FOR IMPARTING B.ARCH.COURSE

 5-year full-time Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.) degree course is to be imparted by an architectural institution in an independent building and land having its own infrastructure and budgetary provisions, as provided under Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020, prescribed by the Council.

Institution must own a minimum 8000 Sq. M. or Independent or undivided and contiguous share of land adequate enough to provide for built floor space of 2,000 Sq.M. for Intake of 40; 3,000 Sq.M. for intake of 80; and 4,000 Sq.M. for intake of 120 in B.Arch. course; provided further that the built space should be contiguous. An institution applying for additional intake shall be required to create adequate infrastructural facilities in proportion to the additional intake sought, as and when sanctioned by the Council (as per the Minimum Standards). The Institution shall ensure that its building and premises and other spaces must be barrier free (i.e. disabled friendly).

- 2. The Institution must have valid affiliation with a University established by an Act of the Central or State Legislature or conferred authority by Law to award Degree Course in Architecture. No admission shall be made by the Institution without valid affiliation with a University. NOC/affiliation letter from the university must be obtained and submitted to the Council at the earliest.
- The Institution having intake of more than 40 students shall be required to conduct separate classes for each batch of 40 candidates or part thereof.
- 4. The Institution shall be required to appoint/maintain the Faculty of Architecture and Physical Infrastructure & Facilities as per the under Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020.
- 5. The eligibility criteria for admission to 1st of 5-year B.Arch. degree course for 2022-2023 is as under:

"No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/ he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics subjects or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject."

- 6. The institution shall admit only such students who have qualify an Aptitude Test in Architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture.
- No direct lateral admission of any student into any year/stage of the B.Arch. course is allowed as per Council Norms.
- 8. All admissions made by the institution under various quotas/categories must be strictly within the intake sanctioned by the Council for an academic session. - 11. The institution must acquire minimum 300 books on subjects of Architecture in its library for an intake of 40 (including minimum 100 titles) before the commencement of the course. Please add 150 books (including minimum 50 titles) for every additional intake of 40. From 2nd year onwards, minimum 120 books (including minimum 40 titles) for every year per intake of 40. Library of old schools, having more than 5000 books, 1 should acquire minimum 10 titles on subjects of Architecture per intake of 40 every year.
- 12. As per Regulations, 2020, in a selection Committee as prescribed by any Institution or University for Selection Process of faculty, there shall be one Nominee of the Council, who shall act as full-fledged member of such Selection Committee constituted for the purpose of recruitment and /or promotion of faculty, except for Centrally Funded Technical institutions (CFTIs). Therefore, recruitments or promotions made to architecture faculty positions in the Institution without COA nominee shall not be deemed valid by the Council.
- 13. The Head as well as other core Architecture teaching faculty of the institution must have valid registration as an Architect from the Council of Architecture under the Architects Act, 1972. The Experience shall mean professional experience and/or Teaching and/or Research in the field of Architecture, counted from the date of registration with Council for core faculty.
- 14. The Institution shall initiate necessary steps to curb ragging in its premises and take appropriate action as prescribed by competent authority in case of any such incident.
- 15. The Institution shall ensure that women (staff, faculty or student) are protected against sexual harassment at the institution and initiate necessary steps as prescribed by competent authority.
- 16. All the circulars/ notices including the intake sanctioned by the Council to Institution(s) shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Institution for information of the students and faculty members. The same shall be available on the website of the institution along with details regarding physical & academic infrastructure and faculty.
- 17. Any Institution which fails to maintain the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education shall be liable to attract sanctions which may include recommendation for withdrawal of recognition the qualification imparted at the Institution.
- 18. The affiliating University of the institution should preferably create an independent Faculty of Architecture and independent Board of Studies in Architecture for proper growth and development of course in Architecture and prepare Syllabus, Course Curriculum, Scheme of Examination in accordance with the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education as prescribed by Council. At least 1/3 of its members should be from the field of practice in Architecture.
- 19. In due course, the affiliating University should preferably also create a Board of Studies in Architecture, Interior Design, Building Construction Technology etc. under the Faculty of Architecture to deal with issues connected with theses disciplines at UG and PG level, having at least 1/3 of its members from practice.
- 20. The institution is advised to constitute an independent Governing Council for a School of Architecture, having Architect members in majority. The institution may also create Course Committees for continuous development of educational programme in Architecture. At least 1/3 of its member may be from practice.

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

- 1) One each Budgetary Quotation from Equipment supplier (all-inclusive i.e. Custom Duty, Bank & other Charges) for all Equipment recommended for support. Please ensure that the budgetary cost is not an inflated one with respect to its specifications given. In case, Equipment list "to be identified & prioritized", please submits quotations of the identified & prioritized Equipment only. Under 'Teaching Facility Support' for Colleges, only laboratory equipment to be utilized for experimental purposes shall be proposed. Teaching Aids like LCD Projector, Smart Boards etc. are out of scope under FIST support and shall not be projected by the College.
- 2) Details plans for implementation of the 'Networking and Computational Facilities' (NW) under the support as per guidelines mentioned in the *Terms and Conditions* of DST-FIST Program available at the Website: <u>www.fist-dst.org</u>.
- 3) Details & their cost estimates of Items/ activities recommended & proposed under 'Infrastructure Facility' which includes the list of Books, etc.

The Department/ Centre/ School or College who have already enjoyed support earlier under FIST Program and recommended for **Repeat Support** now, shall need to complete all formalities i.e. submission of Project Completion Report, Audited Financial Statements, refund of unspent funds etc. for the previously supported project under DST-FIST Program.
