I am glad to inform you that the Council has awarded **SRF** to <u>Ms Malvika Mishra</u>, on a stipend of Rs.35000/-p.m. plus HRA (as admissible). Medical reimbursement will be paid as per rules of your University/College/Institute.

The award of SRF will be subject to the following terms and condition:

<u>TENURE</u>: It will be tenable for one year only from the date of joining duty and further extension will be on yearly basis subject to maximum of <u>36 months</u> & the proposed work should be completed within approved duration. No further extension beyond approved duration will be considered by the Council.

The event of his/her leaving before completing one year on the fellowship, he/she may be required to refund the stipend drawn by him/her from the date of joining to the date of leaving the fellowship.

PRIVATE PRACTICE: Private Practice of any kind, or taking up any appointment even in an honorary capacity during the fellowship is not permitted.

<u>ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL</u>: The candidate will be under the administrative control of the Institution where he/she works, and will also be subject to the rules and regulations of the Institute.

<u>LEAVE</u>: Leave will be admissible according to the rules of the Institution/University. However in the case of female research fellows /Associates 180 day's maternity leave with stipend will be admissible. Research Fellow/Associates are not entitled for vacation normally admissible to the staff of an Institute /University"

HRA. HRA will only be paid, if the fellow is not availing any hostel facility. A certificate to this effect should be sent along with joining report for payment of HRA.

REPORTS: The awardees shall submit 1st annual reports for the first 10 months. On the prescribed standard Performa. The first annual report should be submitted after 10 months from the date of commencement of the fellowship giving complete factual details of the research work done through the Guide along with his/her appraisal.

Subsequent annual report should be submitted through the Guide two months before the completion of fellowship tenure. Failure to submit reports in time may lead to termination of the award. Six copies of the final report in the prescribed form clearly shall be submitted one month before the date of termination of the award.

A list of the papers published or prd at Scientific Conferences during the tenure of the fellowship should also be furnished with the annual and final reports.

<u>PUBLICATION OF PAPERS</u>: Prior permission for publication of papers based on the research work done during the tenure of the award should be obtained from the Council. The papers should be sent to the Council through the Guide with his/her recommendations. Due acknowledgement to the Council should be made in these papers.

PAYMENT OF FUNDS: The stipend and the funds for contingencies shall be paid as per the rules of the Council.

CONTINGENT EXPENDITURE: An annual contingent grant of Rs. 20000/- p.a. will be admissible for the financial year form 1st April to 31st March. In case a fellow join duty after 1st April, the contingent grant will be proportionate to the period of the award in that financial year. Dear Sir/Madam,

The Director-General of the Indian Council of Medical Research sanctions an allotment for Rs. 20,14,160/- (Rupees Twenty lakh fourteen thousand one hundred sixty only) as detailed in the attached budget statement for the above mentioned project for the period of one year i.e. from 14.06.2021 to 13.06.2022 subject to the following conditions:

1. The payment of grant will be released to the head of the Institution. The first instalment of the grant will be paid generally as soon as a report regarding the commencement of the project and appointment of staff is received by the Council. The demand for payment of the subsequent instalment of grant should be placed with the Council in the prescribed Performa attached. The staff appointed in the project should be paid as indicated in the budget statement attached.

The approved duration of scheme is **three years**. The annual extension will be given after review of the work done on the scheme during the previous year. A report on the progress will be submitted to the Council as and when called for.

- 2. While asking for the release of the instalment it may be ensured that the amount for the pay and allowances of the staff who are actually in position is included. The unspent balance available out of grant released will be adjusted in the next year's grant.
- 3. A separate savings bank account for the grant received and expenditure incurred shall be maintained. The account will be subjected to audit by the authorized auditors of the Institutions. In case, facilities are not available for such auditing, the account will be audited by the Council's own internal auditors. Latest by the end of December, following the financial year for which the grant is paid, and audit certificate from the auditors to the effect that the accounts have been audited and that the money was actually spent on the objects for which it was sanctioned shall be submitted to the Council along with a list of non-expendable articles purchased out of the grant during the year. Any unspent balance would be refunded to the ICMR on termination of the scheme.
- 4. Further grants will be stopped unless audited statements of accounts and utilization certificate are received within a period of the year after the end of the financial year for which grant was sanctioned.
- The last instalment of the grant will be paid on receipt of the audited certificate which should include all the liabilities of last year, expenditure incurred before but defrayed after termination of the scheme. The prior to which the expenditure pertains should be shown clearly.

- 6. The grant will not be regarded as a subvention, towards the normal work of the Institution but should be exclusively utilized for the Research activity for which it has been sanctioned.
- 7. Expenditure should on no account exceed the budget sanctioned for the project. For reappropriation of expenditure under different sub-heads (pay & allowances, contingencies, equipments, etc.) within the sanctioned budget and for unspent balance, a request may be sent to ICMR.
 - 8. No expenditure shall however, be incurred by reappropriation of fund on items not sanctioned by the Council i.e. non-consumable equipment, stores not sanctioned by the Council. Fund shall also not be reappropriated for meeting expenditure on staff that has not been sanctioned by the Council.
 - 9. The grant paid by the Council shall be refunded in full by the institution if and when the grantee concerned discontinues a scheme midway or does not follow the detailed technical programme laid down and approved.
 - 10. Receipt, realized by the project officer on behalf of ICMR project, if any, will be remitted to the Council as miscellaneous receipts and not utilized for meeting expenditure of the project.
 - 11. All facilities for conduct of the research scheme, basic equipment and ordinary laboratory chemicals, glassware, furniture and other assistance, as may be required, for the smooth working of the research scheme shall be provided by the Institute.
 - 12. The stores purchased out of the grant of the Council shall be entered in the property stock register and presented to auditors for check and endorsement. The usual forms used for these registers and all purchases made should be in accordance with the procedure in vogue in your institution.
 - 13. Only such equipment for which provision has been made in the budget shall be purchased.
 - 14. All the non-expendable articles purchased out of the funds of the Council will be the property of the Council and will not be disposed of without their concurrence and need to be returned to Council.

STAFF

- 15. The staff employed in the research schemes will not be Council's employee but for all purposes be treated as employees of the Host Institute and will be subject to the rules and administrative control of the Host Institute and will be in accordance with the normal recruitment rules and procedures of the Host Institute.
- 16. The scale of pay, allowances etc. applicable to the staff of the schemes will be the same as admissible under the rules of the grantee Institution. Prior approval of the Council will however be necessary if pay higher than that admissible under the rules of the Institution is sought to be given e.g. by grant of advance increments or ad-hoc increase.
- 17. The Council will not be liable to bear any expenditure on pension provident fund contribution and or leave salary contribution incurred or committed by the grantee and person appointed on deputation from any other organization.

Report of Work Done

- 18. The grant is being sanctioned on the condition that reports on the progress of work done on the research scheme will be submitted by you to the Council as and when called for. Normally a progress report of work done on the enquiry is to be submitted to the Council as and when required, the enquiry maybe discontinued immediately unless there is sufficient justification for non-submission of the report of work done on the research scheme.

Publication

Patents

- 28. The Grant shall be utilized after following provision laid down in GFR-2017 and T.A. rules.
- 29. The budget will be released to Amity University, Rajasthan for both the sites and Host PI will be responsible for submitting the annual/final reports and SOE/UC for both the sites.



2.0 Objectives:

- Customization of nested Regional Climate Model for South Asian CORDEX region with appropriate physical parameterization scheme (cumulus, boundary layer and land surface) and suitable initial condition (Max Plank data, GFDL data, ERAIN15) during summer monsoon season.
- Study of the impact of vegetation schemes on the simulation of summer monsoon during 1981 to 2010 (30 years) with specific focus on excess, normal and deficit summer monsoon seasons (JJAS).
- Study the impact of initialization of the soil moisture on the simulation of Indian summer monsoon rainfall.
- Assimilation of the land cover/vegetation data during the simulation of different epochs (e.g.
 onset, break and withdrawal) of extreme summer monsoon seasons. Also, investigate the impact
 of vegetation on intra-seasonal variation of the Indian summer monsoon.
- Model output diagnostic studies for better understanding of summer monsoon features over south Asian CORDEX domain.

2.1 Programmes:-

Land surface processes play vital role in simulation of rainfall and associated circulation during summer monsoon season over India. Proper representations of land surface processes are essential in climate models for comprehensive understanding of the Indian monsoon and its variability in order to improve model performance. Limited area models are suitable options and widely used for regional scale climate prediction than the global model because of its computational affordability to simulate with high resolution and also resolve sub-grid scale phenomena reasonably well. Regional Climate Model (RegCM), a state of-the-art regional model has been continuously developed over more than two decades at International Center for Theoretical Physics (ICTP) Italy, with regular updates to the model dynamics and physics. Although, RegCM has been widely used for various mesoscale studies, but it has not been tested in detail particularly, the influence of land surface characteristics on summer monsoon and its subseasonal variability over India. In this proposal, latest version of RegCM (version 4.6), a non-hydrostatic dynamical core will be customized over south Asian CORDEX domain and investigate the role of land surface processes on simulation of summer monsoon features. The model supports soil moisture initialization from a previous run for both the BATS and the CLM4.5 surface models. The initialization of surface soil moisture with the RegCM will be tested over Indian Region. Also the landuse/vegetation data over Indian region can be assimilated with RegCM to investigate the model performance in simulating

summer monsoon epochs (onset, break and withdrawal) over India. A detailed study will be carried out with diagnostic analysis during summer monsoon over south Asian CORDEX domain for further improvement of the regional climate model.


