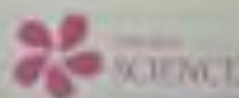

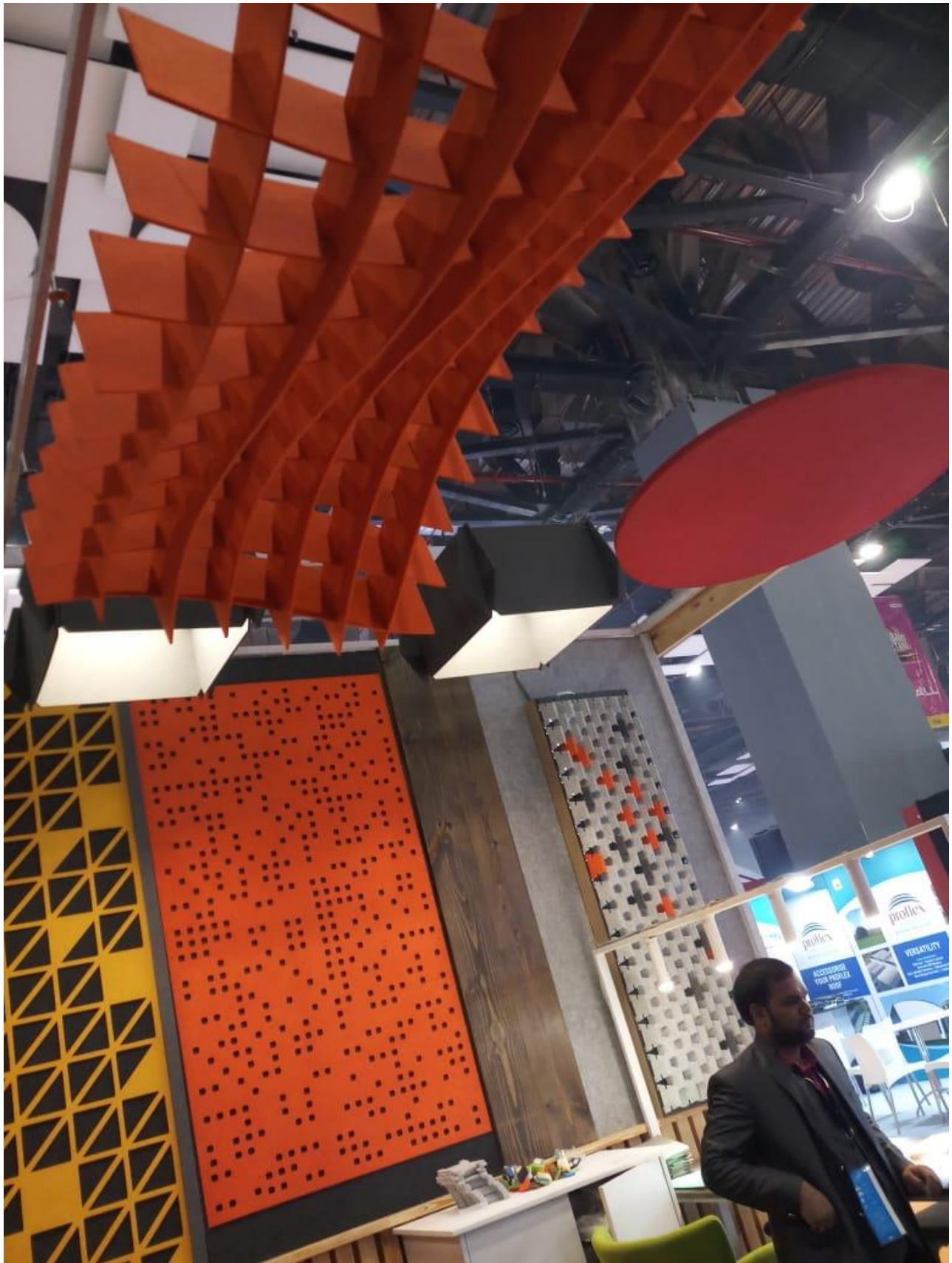


Figure 3 Parametric Ceiling Design of Restaurant
