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

#### Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

#### What does the GMAT exam measure?

The GMAT exam measures basic verbal, mathematical, analytical writing, and integrated reasoning skills that you have developed over a long period of time in your education and work. #### परीक्षार्थियों के लिए मुख्य अनुदेश:


