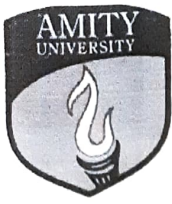

The meeting of BOS, AIBAS was held on the Monday November 27, 2017 in the office of the Director-AIBAS at 12:30 P.M. The following members were present:

The agenda of Academic council meeting is as follows:

1. Presentation of the minor modifications in the structure and syllabi of B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology.
2. Removal of one Minor Track Program of Basic Psychology in CBCS for approval.
3. Merging of M. A. in Counseling Psychology and M A in Clinical Psychology courses of I and II semester wherein specialization will be offered from III Semester for respective Programs.
4. Proposal of one month internship in continuation instead of every Friday/ Saturday in the VI semester of B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology
5. Presentation of a proposal of new evaluation scheme for Behavioral Sciences for approval.

The agenda issues were taken one by one and following suggestions were recommended the BOS:

1. Minutes of previous BOS meeting 2016-17 were confirmed.
2. The minor modifications in the structure and syllabi of B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology



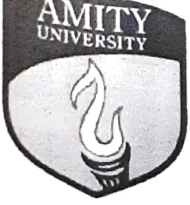
and Behavioral Sciences from Semester I to VI and Minor Track program according to CBCS for approval was presented and approved by all the members. It was proposed that the courses of I and II semesters of M. A in Counseling Psychology and M A in Clinical Psychology should be common and specialization would be offered from III Semester. The same was approved by the members.

3. It was also proposed that there shall be one month internship in continuation between January and March (according to feasibility) instead of every Friday/ Saturday in the VI semester of B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology because, company/industry permit continued training instead of every Friday/ Saturday. The classes would be adjusted accordingly. This was approved by all the members of BOS.
4. Since the existing evaluation scheme (end of semester examination) of BS courses was abolished in the 21st academic council meeting, the new evaluation scheme for Behavioral Sciences was proposed, discussed and approved by the BOS members as presented. The new evaluation scheme is enclosed.

The meeting of BOS AIBAS was held under the convener ship of Prof. Uma Joshi, Director-AIBAS. Following decisions were taken:

The following was the agenda of the meeting:

1. Confirmation of minutes of previous Board of Studies Meeting.
2. Presentation of Proposed Credit Restructuring for Session 2018-19 in BOS for the approval as per the approved Notesheet No: AUR/REG/Committee/2249 dated 15.2.2018.
3. Changes are proposed in CBCS (Minor Track/Open Elective) of AIBAS on the approval of Note-Sheet dated 15.2.2018.
4. Discontinuation of “PG diploma in counselling psychology” program is proposed in front of panel members of BOS due lack of proper licensing and registration policies in this domain.
5. Change of Program from “MA Counselling Psychology” to **MA (Psychology)** is proposed.
6. Presentation of Journal of success as a part of Behavioral Science for approval.

The agenda issues were taken one by one and following suggestions were made:

1. Confirmation of meeting of BOS held on November 27, 2017.
2. New members of BOS were introduced to panel.
3. Credit re-structuring, new program of M.A. (Psychology) and Journal for Success was presented and was approved by the members.



4. Presentation of M.A. (Clinical/Counseling) Psychology and B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology Syllabi.

5. Minor changes were suggested by the BOS members in M.A. (Clinical/Counseling) Psychology and B.A. (Hons.) Psychology Syllabi. In M.A. (Clinical/Counseling) Psychology: diagnostic technique, Trauma care and crisis intervention topics to be included.

In B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology, Psychological practical to be changed to practicum, nomenclature to be changed of few courses, NTCC to be replaced to Field work/Project, rest of the syllabus remains same.

6. Members suggested an evaluation scheme for 60-40 (60 marks for End Term Examinations and 40 marks for Continuous Evaluation) for M.A. (Clinical/Counseling) Psychology and 50-50 (50 marks for End Term Examinations and 50 marks for Continuous Evaluation) for B.A. (Hons.) Applied Psychology.

6. Course Profile and Journal for success was highly appreciated by the members.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
