Minutes of the Meeting: BOS AIBAS held on 28 May 2021


The meeting of BOS, AIBAS was held through online mode on Friday, May 28, 2021. The following members were present in the meeting:

1. Coordinator AIBAS (Dr. Vismita Paliwal) welcomed external member of the BOS.
2. Confirmation of meeting of BOS held on June 25, 2020.
3. Coordinator AIBAS presented Agenda of BOS as follows:-
 - a) New Non Credit Course on a) Foundation Course in Human Values and Professional Ethics b) Expressive Art Holistic Education was proposed. After introduction of new courses a fruitful discussion took place and approved by external members of BOS.
 - b) PG Diploma Course on Forensic Psychology was presented after incorporating the suggestions given by academic Council. Having opened for discussion, external members applauded the course and commented its need for the industry which was supported by Industry Advisory Council.
 - c) Presentation of M.Sc. Psychology (Clinical/Counselling) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Applied Psychology as new programmes with same course structure (changed course codes) to be introduced after the advice of the IAC. The members approved the program and agreed its importance and relevance for the students with science background.
 - d) Next proposed reducing the number of practical on both BA (H) Applied Psychology and MA Psychology program to 6 which was approved by the external members.
 - e) Next Coordinator AIBAS proposed to conduct Workshop for BA (H) Applied Psychology Sem VI and MA (Psychology) Sem IV through virtual mode on account of Covid-19. External members discussed the detail conduction program of workshop on online mode thereafter they approved it.
 - f) BA (Hons) Applied Psychology the following papers were reshuffled:
 - Paper PSY- 402 Defence Psychology was converted as Core Course and PSY 405 Psychology of peace was converted to Domain Elective.



- Paper PSY 502 Forensic Psychology was converted as Core Course and PSY 506 Crime and Delinquency was converted to Domain Elective.
 - g) Next proposed to conduct online Practical Examination for both BA (H) Applied Psychology Sem II, IV and VI, M A (Psychology) Sem II. Having known the whole process of conduction of online exams of practical, members accepted the proposal.
 - h) At last Coordinator AIBAS proposed to allow students to attend/participate online internships (Due to Covid-19) of MA Psychology Sem IV **Internship 1** (Supervised Clinical Practice: University Students) & **Internship 2** a. Counseling Internship in different schools and NGOs including children with special needs, b. Clinical Internship in Industry/Rehabilitation Centre, c. Therapeutic Treatment: Training/Internship, d. Community Counseling: Internship) . Option was provided between online internships/physical internship and case study based assignments due to lockdown. Having a detailed discussion on program structure and its aim the external members approved.
