- Course contents for all new courses introduced in the B. Arch. Program structure (2018-22 and 2019-23 onwards) were presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. The suggestions of the committee were incorporated, and syllabus of the new courses is approved by the committee (Annexure A).
- Credit restructuring for B. Arch. Program was presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. ASAP proposed to reduce the overall credits of the B.Arch. program from 315 to 287 in accordance to CoA Norms. The credit comparative were presented for review, and approved by the committee without any change or modifications (Annexure B).
- 3. While presenting the credit restructuring & syllabus modifications ASAP proposed to remove 'Study tour, NASA & other activities' (from 2nd, 4th & 6th semesters) as a separate NTCC course. The BOS approved of its removal. However, BOS reinforced significance of the activity, and suggested its integration in design courses with 10% marks reserved for study tour. The requisite inclusion was incorporated in syllabus of respective semesters, and approved by the BOS committee.
- 4. ASAP presented syllabus modifications in some of the courses of 3rd, 4th and 5th year of the B.Arch. program structure (2018-onwards). Intent of the revisions was presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. The suggestions of the committee were incorporated, and the modified syllabus of B. Arch. is approved by the committee (Annexure C).

- 1. Credit restructuring for B.ID program was presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. ASAP proposed to reduce the overall credits of the B.ID program from 250 to 218 for uniformity of hours/credit parity across programs. The credit comparative were presented for review, and approved by the committee without any change or modifications (Annexure A).
- Course contents for all new courses introduced in the B.ID program structure (2018-22 and 2019-23 onwards) were presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. The suggestions of the committee were incorporated, and syllabus of the new courses is approved by the committee (Annexure B).
- 3. ASAP presented syllabus modifications in 3rd and 4<sup>th</sup> year courses of the B.ID program structure (2018-onwards). Intent of the revisions was presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. The suggestions of the committee were incorporated, and the modified syllabus of B.ID is approved by the committee (Annexure C).
- 4. While presenting the credit restructuring & syllabus modifications ASAP proposed to remove 'Study tour, NASA & other activities' (from 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4th & 6<sup>th</sup> Semesters) as a separate NTCC course. The BOS approved of its removal. However, BOS reinforced significance of the activity, and suggested its integration in design courses with 10% marks reserved for study tour. The requisite inclusion was incorporated in syllabus of respective semesters, and approved by the BOS committee.
- 5. ASAP proposed swapping of the courses of odd (7th sem. Internship) with even semester (8<sup>th</sup> sem.- Thesis) for B.ID 4<sup>th</sup> year students, only for the academic session 2020-21 in view of Covid-19 disruption. Thus the Thesis was proposed to be conducted in the 7<sup>th</sup> sem., and internship in the 8<sup>th</sup>. BOS committee appreciated the



concern, and recommended its adoption as a special case in consideration of the current scenario of lockdown & COVID 19 pandemic.

- 1. New Program Structure for B. Arch. Program, to include mandatory Anandam Course was presented to BOS committee for review & consideration. ASAP proposed inclusion only in Stage-I to maintain the total credits of the B.Arch. program within 260-300 Credit range to fulfill CoA Norms. New program structure of 299 credits is applicable post commencement for academic session 2020-21 onwards. The credit comparative was presented for review and approved by the committee without any change or modifications (Annexure A).
- Course details of Anandam was presented to BOS committee for review & suggestions towards possible framework of activities. External members suggested to overlap community development aspect of Anandam with Architecture Design Course by framing projects with larger vision.
- Issues pertaining to Program duration, program content, admission, and entrance exam in the light of NEP2020 were apprised to BOS for recommendations. Prof Alok Ranjan apprised BOS that National level committee is working out the details.
- 4. Major groupings and possibilities in UG and PG programs were presented to BOS to seek recommendation on new feasible programs for launch at ASAP. External Members ideologically supported launch of new programs at ASAP, AUR but also suggested focusing on diversification at Post Graduation level and to conduct feasibility survey.
