MINUTES OF THE 8th BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING



MINUTES FOR THE BOARD OF STUDIES [FINE ARTS], HELD ON 24 April 2018

1. Master of Fine Arts programs may appeal to those students that have completed a baccalaureate program in a fine arts discipline and are interested in furthering both their skills and their education. Graduates can go on to become professional artists, though it should be noted that employment requirements vary widely for professional artists, and graduate-level education is not always required. Depending on their undergraduate education, students may pursue an MFA in various specializations on Painting, Applied Arts and sculpture. MFA programs help current or aspiring artists develop conceptual and technical skills in their area of gaining in-depth knowledge.
2. It is our 14th Academic Council Meeting (Item No.4.4) approved by the BOS Members. So for our students of MFA specialization is required to pursuing their studies. This specification will MFA can help them to build their artistic skills in the field of interest, so that they can pursue a career as an artist or enroll in a related doctoral program.
3. BFA/MFA specialization has to be particularly mentioned in Degree distribution as Applied Art, Painting and Sculpture
