## ORIENTATION PROGRAMME 2020



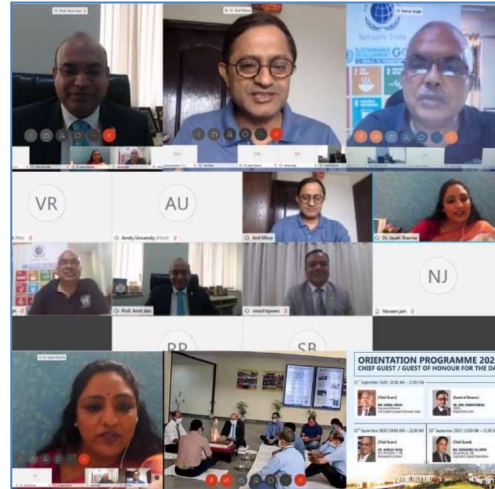
Day 1 - The first day was dedicated for online registrations.

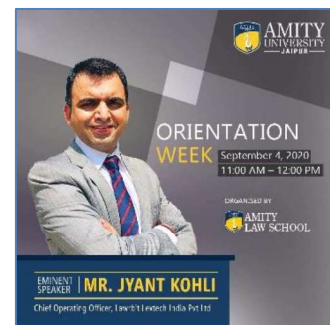
Hostels, Discipline and Anti-ragging by respective heads. Post lunch, event- Talent Hunt was scheduled.

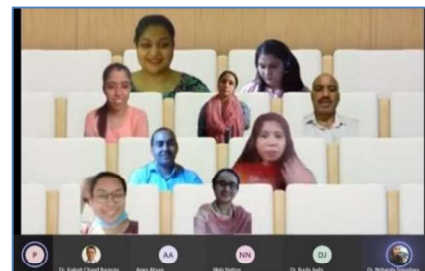
