

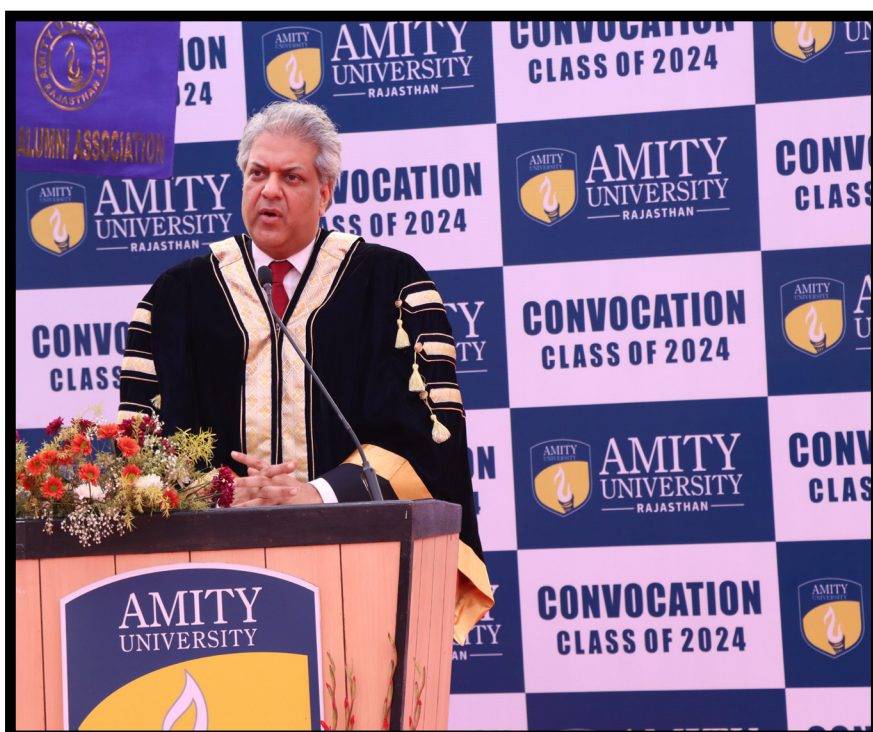

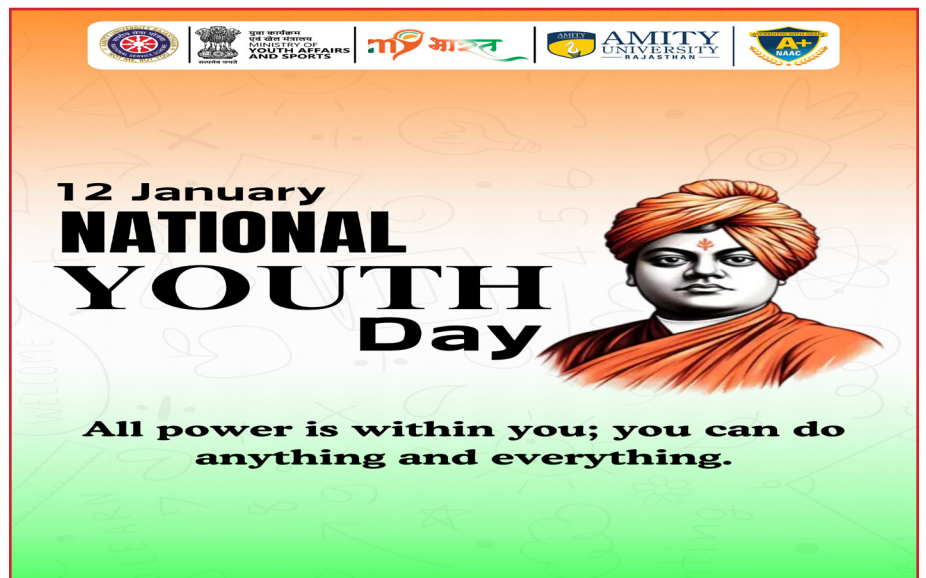
NSS organised seven-day Special Camp

UBA & AIMT provided farmers free organic inoculants to encourage eco-friendly farming.

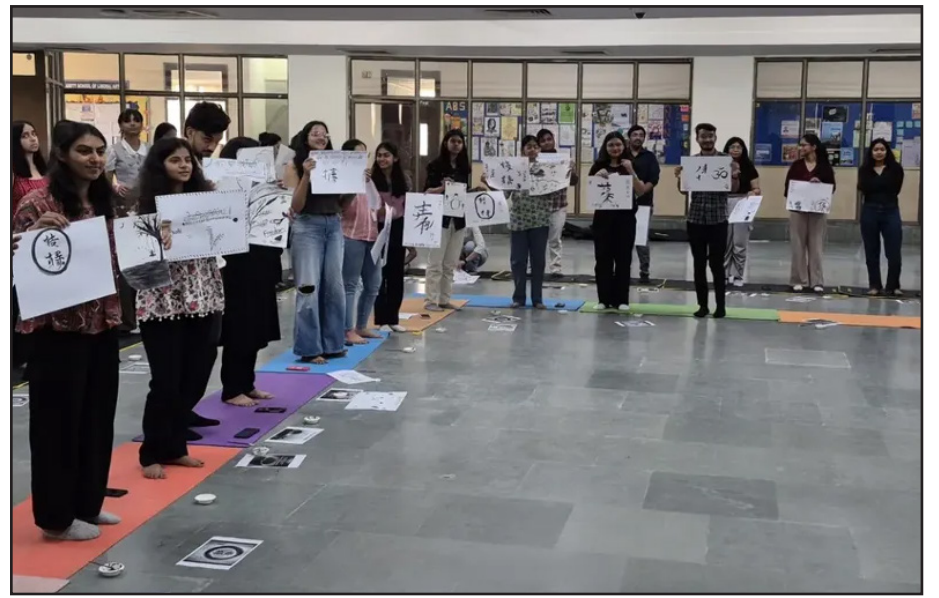


NSS AUR organized Blanket Donation Drive at Syari Village

Guest Lecture on “Strategic Marketing Communication: Crafting Impactful Messages in the Digital Age”



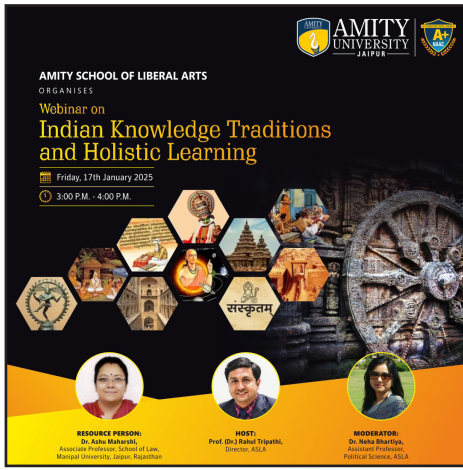

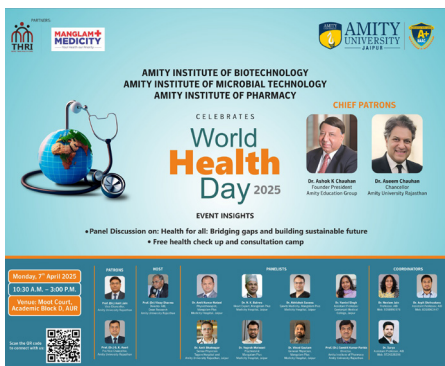

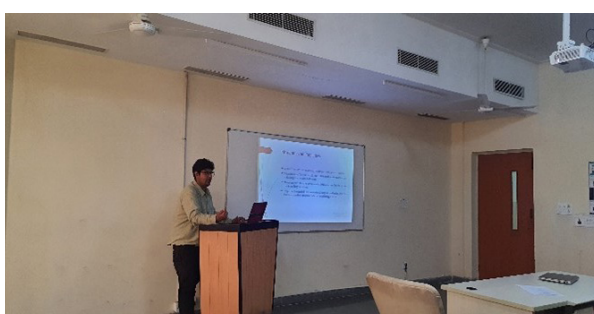
A one-day workshop on Generative AI

AIPT observed World Rheumatoid Arthritis Day

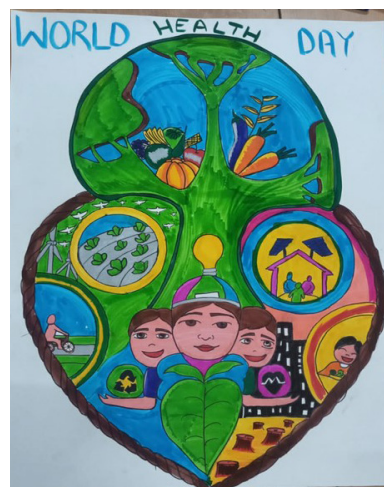

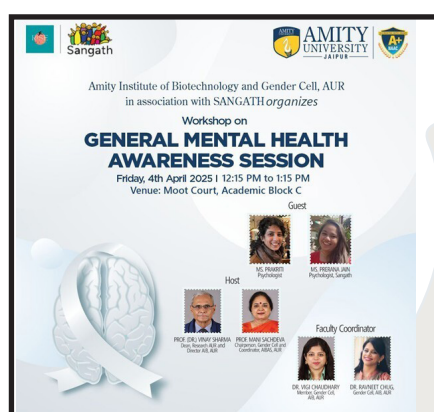

Workshop on Salesforce (Admin & Development)



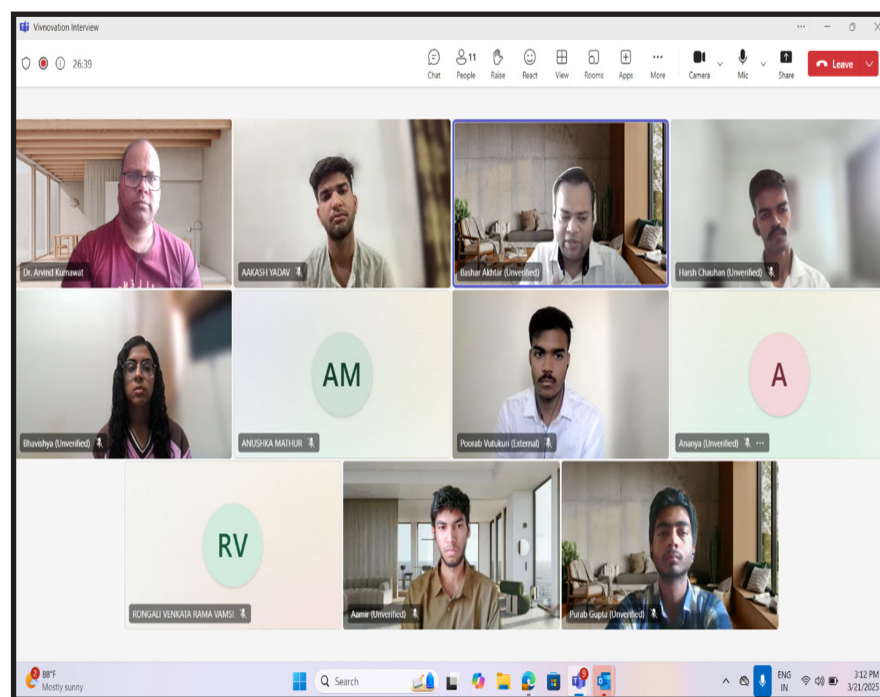

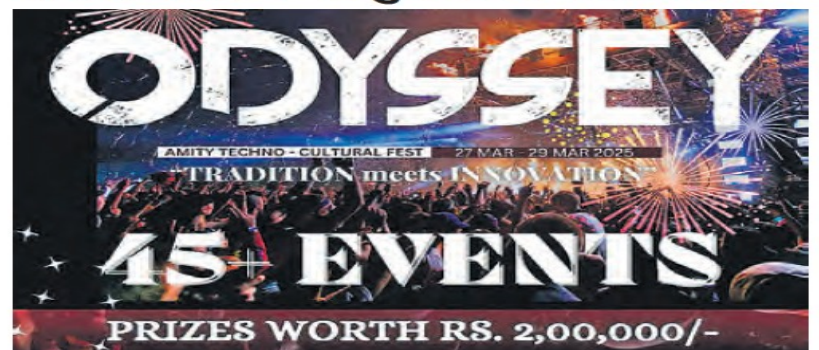
‘विकसित भारत रोड मैप पर स्वच्छ भारत को सफल बनाना आवश्यक’

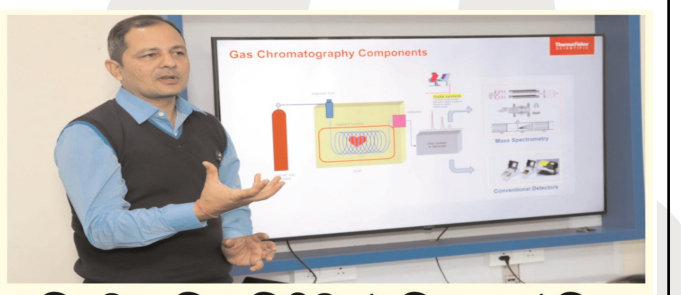
