

From that day onward I knew what I was meant to do, and today I am pursuing the same in some form or the other. I love being in front of the camera now (posing or talking), whichever way

While every moment at Amity was special, a defining experience for me happened during my second year when I had to take eighteen exams at once after being debarred from eight subjects the previous semester. It was a high-stakes situation that had both me and my faculty deeply concerned, but their incredible support motivated me to truly "pull up my socks" and give it everything I had. I still vividly remember the moment Jayati Ma'am called me during my summer break to tell me not only that I had passed, but that I had placed second in my class. The sheer excitement of that achievement was unforgettable, but what I cherish most was hearing the genuine pride and happiness in Jayati Ma'am's voice. Another highlight was participating in an open mic competition where we were given spontaneous, high-pressure situations to manage in front of a live crowd. I was initially very reluctant to join, but I decided to push past that hesitation and participate anyway. Not only did I manage to navigate the challenge successfully, but I ended up placing second—an experience that really reinforced the importance of stepping out of my comfort zone and trusting my ability to handle the unexpected.

Stay focused and never give up. The road to success may be patchy and difficult, but resilience and agility are key to steering past every obstacle and growing. Always carry your learnings with you, and remember that your future is in your hands; make the most of everything you are learning today.

What advice would you offer to students who want to make the most of their university life at Amity?

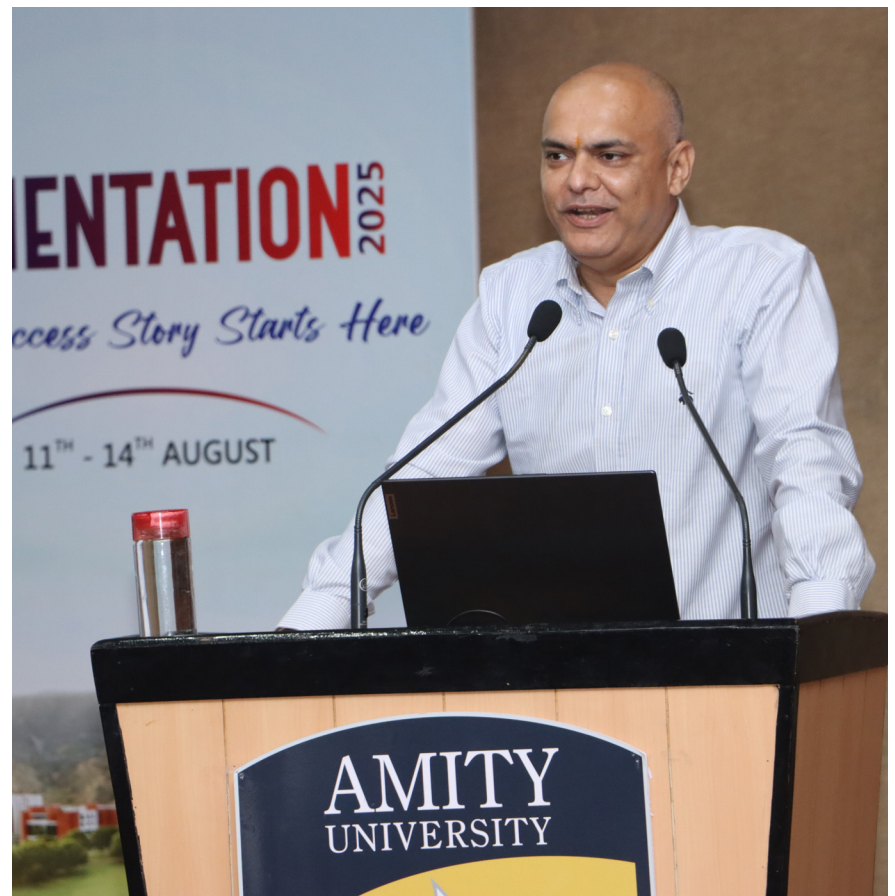

Navigating Global Media Careers: Interactive Workshop with Deutsche Welle at ASCO

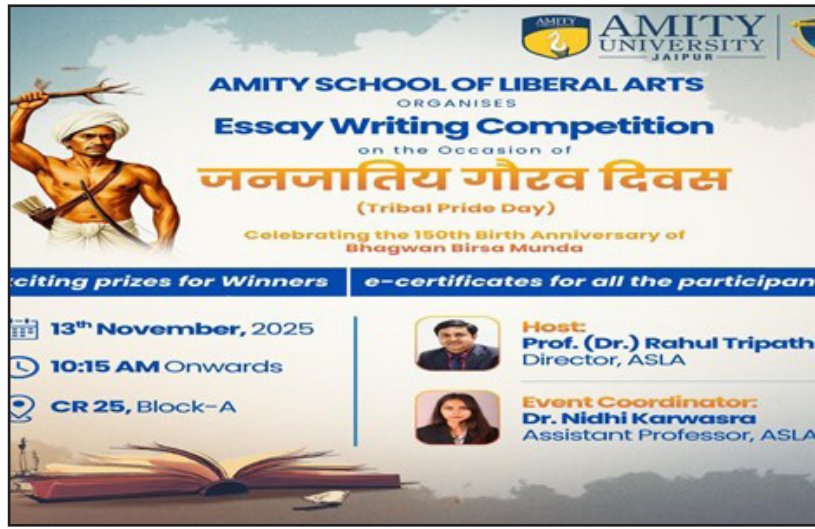

Quiz Competition on Constitution Day



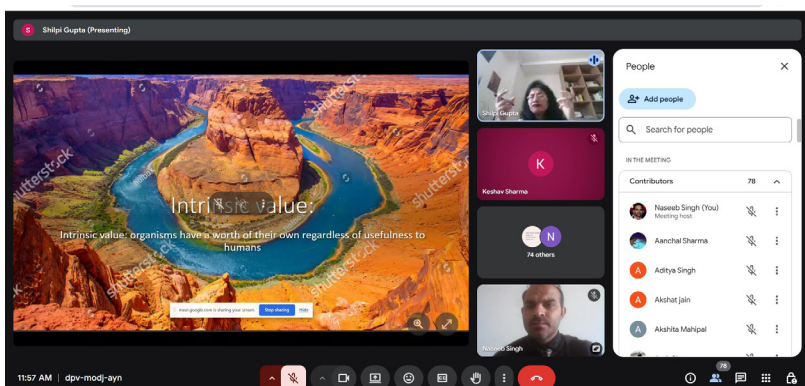

on topics such as advances in anthrax vaccine development, equitable healthcare and translational medicine, eco-friendly management of plant viral diseases, research ethics and publication integrity, AI-driven diagnostics under One Health, and molecular mechanisms of drug resistance and stress biology. ESCAP-2025 provided tangible benefits by fostering research collaborations, enhancing publication opportunities, and exposing young researchers to emerging scientific methodologies.

AIB organizes Sustainability with Seed Ball Drive and SDG-Aligned Eco Event



AIB organized an engaging sustainability-focused event featuring Seed Ball Making, an Environmental Quiz, and a Photography Contest, aimed at promoting environmental conservation and climate action among students. Food Festival showcases Awadhi & Mughlai cuisine



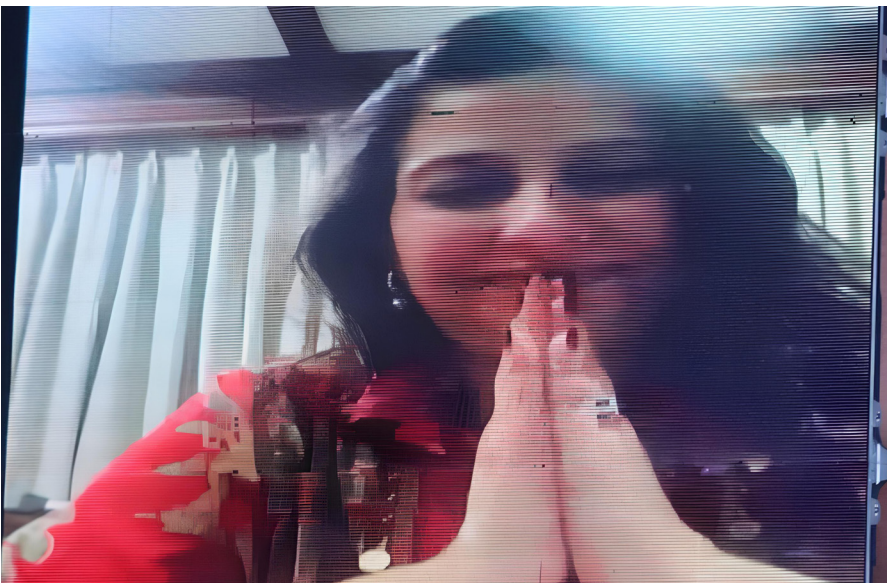

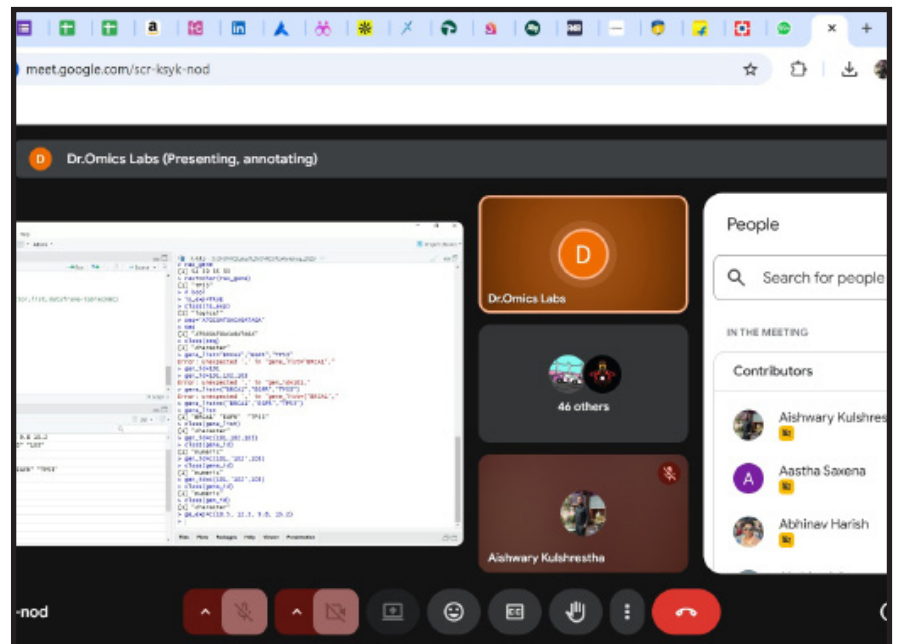

International Day for the Elimination of Gender Violence

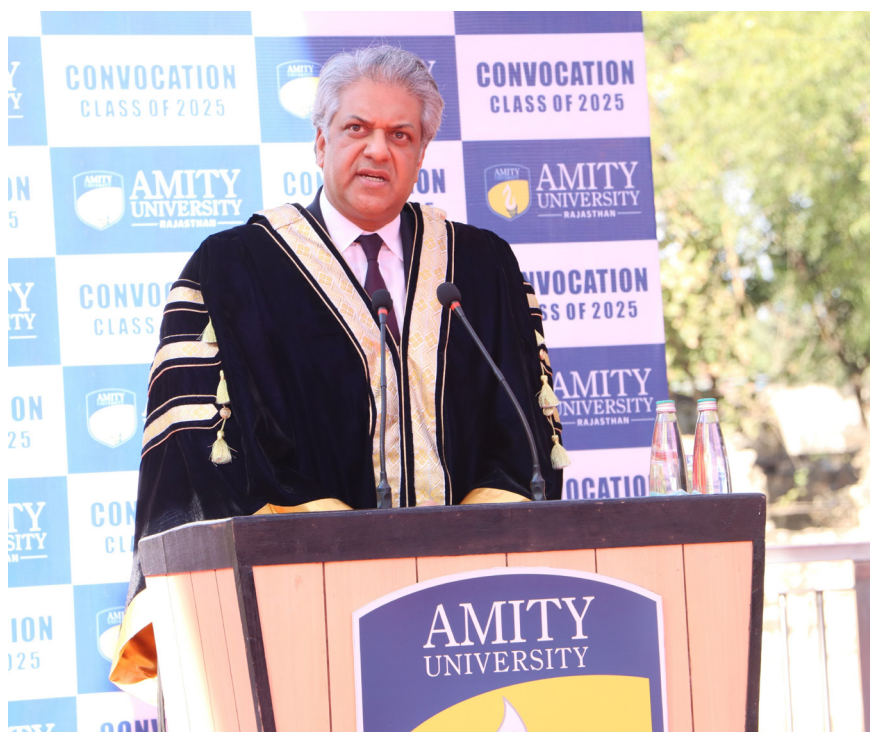
