### Message from the Pro-Vice Chancellor

All departmental meetings were shifted online, and proper coordination was ensured through online video conferencing between team members for successful academic delivery and administrative efficiency. Several webinars and expert sessions were conducted to help individuals and corporates cope up with the changes and lead in an effective way in a volatile, uncertain, complex, and ambiguous business environment. 


The day ended with the dedicated messages for the teachers expressing the student's gratitude and by presenting gifts to the faculties.
