Community Outreach Activity – Bhatan Highschool Visit to Exhibition on –‘Tourism: Pathways to Peace and Prosperity’

The inspiration stemmed from the idea to engage local community students in a learning environment, promoting awareness of tourism’s role in fostering global peace and cross-cultural understanding. This initiative aimed to introduce students to the educational potential of tourism and its real-world impact on peacebuilding and international cooperation. Additionally, it aligned with the broader goal of bridging the gap between academic institutions and the community by offering a hands-on learning experience in a fun, interactive setting.

The exhibition provided valuable insights for both students and teachers, including:

Knowledge of how tourism can act as a tool for peacebuilding in conflict zones such as Africa and the Far East. Awareness of cultural exchange and its importance in fostering global harmony. An

understanding of tourism's economic and social benefits in promoting development and cooperation among nations. Interactive learning through questions and answers regarding travel destinations, maps, and tourism's role in international relations. HOI – AITT addressed the students and spread the message of peace and resilience from cultural interaction through tourism. Students of the school had interaction opportunity with students pursuing Bachelor and Master program at Amity Institute of Travel and Tourism, Amity University Mumbai. This helped in creating aspirational group for school students.
