



Memorandum of Understanding Parties to the Memorandum:

Department of the Built Environment, LJMU

And

RICS School of Built Environment, Amity University

1. Overall Aim and Objectives of Collaboration:

1.1 The Department of the Built Environment, Liverpool John Moores University and RICS School of Built Environment, Amity University, having decided to enter into a cooperative relationship for the general purpose of promoting educational, research and cultural programmes for the mutual benefit of both parties, hereby agree as follows:

1.2 The two institutions shall promote opportunities for co-operation within the above mentioned areas. Such activities may include, but need not be limited to:

- (a) development of admission/articulation agreements and educational programmes;
- (b) co-operation on academic, administrative and curriculum matters;
- (c) collaboration on research projects; and
- (d) exchange of academic and administrative staff and students.

2. Scope of this Memorandum of Understanding:

- 2.1 This Memorandum records the intention of both parties to explore areas of joint activity which further the Overall Aim and Objectives described above. It is not a legally binding agreement. Neither party will use the name of the other in any published documents or publicity material, except with the consent of the other party.
- 2.2 Each activity carried out within the broad framework of this Memorandum shall be subject to the mutual consent of both parties taking into account constraints of time, funding and other relevant resources.
- 2.3 Additionally, each activity shall be governed by terms and conditions to be separately negotiated and mutually agreed by both parties through discussion and the signing of a separate Memorandum of Cooperation.

3. Duration and Termination of this Memorandum of Understanding:

3.1 The duration of this Memorandum will be for three (3) years from the date of signing.

3.2 Either party may revoke this Memorandum by giving at least 90 days advance notice.
