### 6.1 Speaker's Brief Profile

### Profile of Prof. (Dr.) Shyamalendu Niyogi

He is an Advisor (RBEF & AHF) : Director, NRDC AMITY Innovation Facilitation Centre: Professor AUUP, Noida, Prof. Niyogihas formerly worked as Managing Director, Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited/DVVNL; He has also worked as a Director HR, LEGAL, Corporate Relations & Planning, GAIL INDIA LTD., New Delhi; He has also been Director or Andrew Yule Company Ltd, Kolkata; Tide water Oil Company Ltd. Kolkata; Dishergarh Power Supply Company Limited, Director, Yule Financing Company Limited, Kolkata; Hoogly Printing Company Ltd, Kolkata; Mahanagar Gas Limited, Mumbai, 1GL, New Delhi, 1MS, Dehradun, IILM, Greater Noida. He was also the Chairman and Managing Director of Cycle Corporation Limited. Kolkata; Governing Body, ICFAI University, Dehradun; He is also a Member, Governing Body, ISM Unison University. Dehradun.

### Profile of Dr. Dinesh P. Patil

Dr. Dinesh P. Patil is the Deputy Controller of the Patents and Design and Head of office at office of Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Govt of India. He's a PhD in biochemistry and has more than 16 years of experience in Indian patent office in various capacities. He has obtained various foreign trainings including patenting of pharmaceutical inventions from Japan Patent Office in 2006, he has also represented India thrice as Delegation of India in 21st, 22nd and 24th Sessions of Standing Committee on Law of Patents (SCP) at WIPO, Geneva, which is a specialized UN agency on IPRs (Nov. 2014, Jul. 2015 and Jun.2016). He has significantly contributed in preparing Patent Examination Guidelines for Examiner of Patents in the field of (i) Traditional Knowledge (TK), (ii) Biotechnology; and (iii) Pharmaceuticals.

### Profile of Dr. Vishal. G. Warke

Dr. Vishal G. Warke is a reputed Scientist and is currently the R&D Director of Cell culture & Immunology divisionat HiMedia Laboratories Private Limited. He completed his Doctoral research in Cell Biology and Molecular Genetics from the University of Maryland, MD, USA after graduating as Medical Doctor (M.B.B.S) from the University of Mumbai. He has been awarded the Medical Research Fellowship of 'The Walter Reed Army Institute of Research' (June 2002), Silver Spring, MD, USA. As a leader of the next generation of HiMedia, he has done Pioneering work in diverse areas of biosciences and has broadened the portfolio of the organization. He has successfully established the animal tissue culture, plant tissue culture and the hydroponics department. He has worked on the design and development of media for biosimilar production. He has been an active member of several reputed scientific bodies and a PI for many collaborative translatable projects. He has more 20 peer reviewed publications In leading journals and his work is highly acknowledged in the international scientific community.

### **Profile of Prof Mrudula Bele**

Prof. Mrudula Bele is a pharmacist by training with a PhD in Pharmaceutical Sciences having strong interest in Intellectual Property Rights and Regulatory Affairs for pharmaceuticals. Additionally, possessing a Post Graduate Diploma in Patents law from the NALSAR University of Law, LL.B. from Pune University and LL.M. from University of Turin, Italy with full fellowship. She is currently working as an Associate Professor at NDMVP's College of Pharmacy, Nashik. She has authored three books, several research papers in several national and international journals. She authored a column in a reputed newspaper loksatta (Katha Akalechya Kaaydyachi) on various aspects of Intellectual Property Law. Dr. Samir Kulkarni, a recognized leader in the Indian Biologics industry with a cumulative, experience of about two decades presently working as the Director: Innovation, Incubation and Linkages (University of Mumbai) .He is also the Chairman of Intellectual Property Rights Cell at the University of Mumbai, A Member Secretary: Board of Deans, Board of Innovation and Enterprise, Board of Linkages, Member: Senate and Academic Council and Director of

National Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (University of Mumbai) . He has a degree in Executive Management from IIM Bangalore), PhD (Chemical Engineering, UDCT), Masters in Bioprocessing (UDCT) and bachelor's degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences (Pune University). He has played an Instrumental role in successful Launch of several monoclonal antibodies and other biosimilars in India and Europe. He is also responsible for Process corrections, risk mitigation, strategic program coordination for several biopharmaceutical projects and is a Principal inventor in 20+ Patent applications in biopharmaceutical processes.

### Profile of Dr. S. N. Teli

Presently working as Professor, Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Engineering, Navi Mumbai he is PhD, MTech and B tech in Mechanical Engineering with 22 years of teaching experience, 9 Design Patents Published, 124 research articles published in refereed journals, International & National Conference and more than 300 citations and 25 books published . He has four research proposals granted from University of Mumbai and has received award various awards like "Outstanding Contribution in Academic and Research" given by CEMS (Govt. of India), Mumbai, September, 2019 on occasion of Teacher's day , "Academic Excellence Award" given by St.John College of Engineering, Palghar, Aug 2019, "Research Award" given by Saraswati College of Engineering, September, 2015, "Invaluable Service & Contribution in AICTE work", given by Saraswati College of Engineering, July 2011 and "Good performance & Sincerity" given by Rajendra Mane College of Engineering , Devrukh, March 2001.

### **Profile of Dr. Smita Sahu**

She is an Associate Professor, Registered Indian Patent Attorney IN/PA 2601, Certified IP Trainer by the Japan Patent Officer. She is currently Running a DST funded Research Project as a Principal Investigator entitled, 'Affordable medical devices and equipment – Priority medical technology needs in India', She has filed nine copyrights, got four copyrights registered, thirteen research papers published in reputed journals and she has also authored two books. She was also invited as Guest Faculty/resource person at IIT Delhi, Central University and other Academic Institutions on IPR Promotion & Awareness. Associated with Amity Science Technology & Innovation Foundation (ASTIF) Amity Directorate of Science & Innovation (ADSI) and taking care of Amity Patent filings, prosecution and IP Management and Copyright, she coordinates the major Activities being undertaken by the NRDC-Amity Innovation Facilitation Centre. She will be talking on Capturing Innovations in University setups- Best practices in this workshop.

### Summary of the talk by each speaker

**Prof. (Dr.) Shyamalendu Niyogi** started the session with an introduction of Amity University. He talked about the vision, mission and dynamic leadership of Founder President Sir, C5 Sir and President C6 Sir in making Amity University one of the most highly reputed institutes nationally and internationally. He gave some examples about the leadership and motivation of these dynamic leaders towards taking the Amity Institutions to the top as innovative, creative and research driven institutions. He spoke about the importance and benefits of IPR and gave brief introduction to Patents and other laws relating to IPR. He shared his experiences of working with various organizations. He also congratulated Amity University Mumbai, its management, faculty members and students for organizing this seminar and encouraged speakers.

**Dr. Dinesh Patil** started with basic concept of IPR and discussed various types of IPR. He gave an in-depth knowledge of Patents, Designs and Trademarks and the legal framework related to these like The Patents Act 1970, the Trademark Act, 1999 and the Copyright Act ,1957. He also discussed the concepts like industrial designs and geographical indications. He then discussed about the difference between industrial IPR and copyrights along with shift from agricultural economy to industrial economy to knowledge-based economy.

**Dr. Vishal. G. Warke** spoke about innovation, IPR and dynamism in terms of patents. He also spoke about the potential problems that India is facing because of IPR infringement. Dr. Vishal shared the story of Hi-media, which was founded by his father, his mother and his uncle as a response to the need of scientists. Hi media received the Rajiv Gandhi National Quality Award in 2006 and 2011, the only company to receive the award twice. He also discussed about the struggles of a technocrat venture. He emphasised that whatever business a person does, it should leave legacy and advised the students that whatever business they do it should be ecologically sustainable. He stated that India needs to develop an effective innovative ecosystem and global competitiveness and absorb and adapt to technological innovations from abroad in order to prosper more and more.

**Prof. Mrudula Bele** spoke about the basic features of IPR and what kind of Intellectual Property needs to be protected. She then moved on to discuss that why it is important for an inventor to patent and discussed the advantages of patent. She also discussed various concepts like invention, novelty and industrial application with plethora of examples to make the concepts crystal clear. She then discussed certain interesting and landmark cases like (1) Diamond vs Chakrabarty (2) Association of Molecular Pathology vs Myriad Genetics (3) Oliver Brustle vs Green Peace (4) Turmeric Patent Case. She also gave us an insight into Traditional Knowledge Digital Library (TKDL).

**Dr. Samir Kulkarni** talked about patenting in bio pharmaceutical and discussed how these kinds of patent are used in the industry. He also gave us a brief insight into biopharmaceutical and stated that they are extremely complex to develop. The chronology of drug discovery and different ways in which drugs can be patented in the Indian

scenario was also discussed. According to Dr. Kulkarni India is known as the "Pharmacy of World" because we can provide generic medicine to the world and discovery in these aspects are needed.

**Dr. Shivanand Teli** spoke about Patent Process in technology with hands on experience and case study discussion. He spoke about Design Patent and its registration process. In the beginning the process involves filling of Design Disclosure Form wherein the applicant must upload the photographs of his product, write about advantages and applications of their product. He further stated that it is very important that the product to be unique and innovative. He also gave vital information to the students that every Friday nearly five hundred patents are shown on the Government website. By surfing the site, one will be able to keep pace with latest happenings taking place in the field of Patent.

**Dr. Smita Sahu** started the session by using a very famous phrase "When you are good at something, don't do it for free". This was used in the context of IPR. She motivated the audience by asking them to generate ideas and own them, as IPR is created by using human intellect. She gave an insight into IP Portfolio and the importance of IPR. IPR encourages innovation and rewards the creators of the same. She also said that 'we shouldn't let our invention die in the valley of death'. Dr. Smita Sahu spoke about IPR cell procedural aspects at Amity University and gave an insight that filing of patent application has increased drastically in Amity University.
