To empowering them by opening avenues of income generation and helping them to become professionals. This program is conducted since 2016 onwards till date every year. This is Skill Training Program conducted by the Amity School of Fashion and Design Technology (ASFDT) at Amity University Maharashtra. The Param Foundation (Navi Mumbai) has donated 30 sewing machines to School of Fashion Design & Technology, Mumbai, and the sewing machines are utilized during the Design Intervention program for the women.
