Legal Aid Camp & Environment Day

On the occasion of World Environment Day, Amity Law School and Amity Institute of Liberal Arts had jointly organized Legal Aid Camp and celebrated World Environment Day at Phansad Wild Life Sanctuary in Tal. Murud, Dist. Raigad. It was Interdisciplinary activity that aimed to understand tribal life. Phansad Wild Life Sanctuary is located in Raigad District and spread across 52 Kilometer. There are leopards, wild bore, birds, deer, and butterflies.



Sumradevi Tribal Hamlet is near Phansad, and 35 tribal families reside there. These families are Katkari Tribes which are Primitive Tribes, and the majority of them are settled in Raigad District. These families depend on daily wage activities for their livelihood. Therefore, there is a major issue of accessibility of Education and Healthcare

Facilities. There are no toilets in this area; hence, personal hygiene and health are the major issues.

Gender discrimination was observed as the disparity in payment to men and women. Men are paid higher than women for equal work
