# B. <u>Scale of Pay</u>: Pay Band Rs. 9300-34800/- (PB-II) and Grade Pay Rs. 4200/-.

In addition to Pay they will also be eligible for DA, NPA, HRA and Transport Allowance as per rules in force from time to time.

**C.**Age Limit: Not exceeding 30 years as on 10th November 2015. Upper age limit is relaxable to SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Ex-Servicemen & other categories of persons as per rules/instructions of Govt. of India. Upper age limit is relaxable up to 5 years for Government/ESIC employees in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Govt.

Candidates should note that the Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation /Secondary Examination Certificate will only be accepted for determining the age.

# D. <u>Process of Certification and Format of Certificates:</u>

Applications from the eligible candidates are called through ONLINE application. Candidates are not required to submit hard copy of the application/ requisite documents at the time of filling online application.

The requisite essential documents will be verified in subsequent stage(s). Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserved or seek age-relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the competent authority in the prescribed format at the time of Interview/Document Verification. Otherwise their claim for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EXS status will not be entertained and their candidature /application will be considered under General (UR) category. The formats of certificates are annexed. Certificates in any other format will not be accepted.

# Mode of payment: -

- **i.** The candidates who are not exempted from payment of application fee should pay the requisite fee by generation of challan through online application.
- **ii**. Fee once paid will **not** be refunded under any circumstance.
- iii. To pay the fee, candidate shall have to take the print out of challan generated online after filling application and uploading scanned photograph and signature. Deposit the requisite fee in any branch of State Bank of India and then take print out of online application. The fee is to be paid only through State Bank of India. Detailed instructions for filling online application and generation of challan are available on the website.
- **iv.** Women candidates, ESIC Employees and candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Person with Disabilities (PWDs) and Ex-serviceman are exempted from paying fee. The candidates exempted from payment of fee are not required to generate challan for payment of fees. Such candidates can submit online application and take print out of online application.
- V. Fees paid by modes other than through SBI Challan as indicated above will **not** be accepted and the applications of such candidates will be rejected forthright and the payment made shall stand forfeited.
- **Vi.** Copy of challan through which fee is paid must be retained by the candidate and produced on demand.

# G. HOW TO APPLY

i. Candidates must apply online through the website <u>www.esic.nic.in</u>. No other means/mode of application will be accepted. Applications received through any other mode will not be accepted and will be summarily rejected. - ii. Detailed Instructions for filling online application are available on the website. Candidate should read the instructions carefully before making any entry or selecting options.
- iii. After submitting the online application, the candidates are required to take print out of the finally submitted online application and retain the same with them.
- iv. Candidates are not required to submit ESIC either by post or by hand the printouts of their online applications or any other document. They will be required to submit printout of online application along with documents in support of their eligibility etc. in case they are short listed for Interview.
- V. The candidates are advised to submit only single online application. However, if somehow, he/she submits multiple online applications, then he/she must ensure that online application with the higher "Registration Number" is complete in all respects including fee. The applicants, who submit multiple online applications, should note that only the online application with higher "Registration Number" shall be entertained by the ESIC and fee paid against one "Registration Number" shall not be adjusted against any other "Registration Number".
- Vi. Application once submitted cannot be modified; hence utmost care should be taken to furnish the correct details before submitting the online application.
- **vii.** Candidates are required to keep active the Email-ID and the Mobile Number during the currency of this recruitment process. ESIC may also send Interview Letters for interview and other communication only at the registered email ID of candidates. Hence under no circumstances, the candidates should provide email ID to anyone.
- Viii. Before applying online, candidate will be required to have a scanned (digital) image of his/her recent photograph and signature for uploading. The scanned photograph and signature should be in JPG/JPEG format only and the digital size of the each file i.e. scanned photograph and signature must be between 5 kb to 50 kb.
  - ix. Candidate should first scan their photograph and signature, ensuring that both the photograph and signature are as per the prescribed specifications. If the size of the file is less than 5 kb or more than 50 kb then adjust the settings of the scanner (or resize the image).

- IV. The Qualifying Marks in Part I will be 40% (i.e. 80 Marks out of 200) for Unreserved (UR) Category and 35% (i.e. 70 Marks out of 200) for Reserve Categories (SC/ST/OBC) and Sub Category (PWD).
- V. There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer in Part-I. Candidates are therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.
- VI. Corporation will place the answer keys of Part-I on its website after the examination. Objections and claims if any, received within the time limit specified while placing answer keys will be examined by the Corporation with the help of experts, if necessary. Corporation's decision in this regard will be final.

# PART II - INTERVIEW - 50 MARKS.

The candidates who are short listed on the basis of performance in Part-I will be called for interview. The interview will be held at places as may be decided by the Corporation.

#### **MODE OF SELECTION:**

The final selection for the post of <u>Junior Engineer (Civil)</u> and <u>Junior Engineer (Electrical)</u> will be made on the basis of Written Examination followed by interview of eligible and successful candidates.

Candidates who are unable to download their Admission Certificates should contact ESIC with details such as Application Number, print out of online application, copy of challan, etc. for obtaining the Admission Certificates. #### L. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT

Without prejudice to criminal action/debarment from ESIC's examination wherever necessary, candidature will be summarily cancelled at any stage of the recruitment in respect of candidates found to have indulged in any of the following:-

- i In possession of MOBILE PHONE & ACCESSORIES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE EXAMINATION CENTRES, WHETHER IN USE OR IN SWITCH OFF MODE AND ON PERSON OR OTHERWISE.
- ii Involved in malpractices.
- iii Using unfair means in the examination hall.
- iv Obtaining support for his / her candidature by any means.
- v Impersonate/ procuring impersonation by any person.
- vi Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.
- vii Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information.
- viii Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination.
- ix Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall with the Supervisor, Invigilator or ESIC's representatives.
- x Intimidating or causing bodily harm to the staff employed by the ESIC for the conduct of examination.

# M. ESIC'S DECISION FINAL

Disqualification: - No person,

- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person Shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Director General of the Employees State Insurance Corporation may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these regulations.
