


Are You ready with Competencies needed

Highlights

- This is a team event. Each team would comprise of 3 members from the same institution.
- Registered teams to participate in the college level contest.
- Contest duration is about 5 hours. There will be about 7 problems for you to solve. You are required to solve as many problems as you can within this time, which are of varying complexity.
- Appropriate online software development environment will be utilized for conducting live contest
- FOUR best performing teams from each zone will be selected for participation in DC Programming contest finals by automated evaluation of submitted solutions.
- College level winners will receive certificates
- DC level finals will select winner and runner-up team for the National finals
- Winner and runner-ups will receive certificates and exciting prizes in DC finals and National finals
- National level finals will select winner and runner-up team across states
- Possibility of National finalists who meet criteria, direct entry to ACM ICPC online/ onsite Regional Finals in India
