About MoEs Mentor-Mentee 2021-22:

The Mentor-Mentee 2021-22 is a twinning program for IIC institutions designed to facilitate knowledge exchange and resource mobilization between IIC institutions by offering inter-institutional collaborations and peer mentoring support during the IIC 4.0 calendar year (Oct 21 - March 22). Twinning will be made in the ratio of 1 Mentor IIC institution with 5 Mentee IIC institutions.

Mentor institutions will receive financial support from MIC/AICTE to provide mentoring and handholding support to mentee institutions by organising a set of prescribed activities for mentee institutions and enabling them to lead and streamline campus I&E ecosystems.

Ideally, prospective mentee IIC institutions are those IIC institutions that have scored 2.5 stars and below in IIC2.0 annual performance and those newly joined IIC Institutions during the IIC3.0 period with a functional MY COUNCIL. On a first-come-first-serve basis, these prospective mentee institutions will get an opportunity to choose a mentor IIC institute of their choice.

Each mentee institute can give their preference up to three mentor institutions by selecting from the dropdown option in the order starting with from their own state, own zone or outside the zone according to the availability of mentor institutions.

Through this scheme, approximately 50-60 nos of high performing IIC institutions will act as mentor to 250-300 IIC institutions as mentee on a ratio of 1:5. Each eligible mentor institute will get funding assistance of up to Rs. 40,000/- per mentee institute and expected to mentor 5 mentee institute from MIC/AICTE to organise the prescribed activities for mentee institutions.

Expected Outcomes:

- Active participation and involvement of students, faculties and staff and most importantly members of the IIC institute in the program.
- Awareness generation among students, faculties and staff on recent developments and approaches in for innovation, entrepreneurship and intellectual property and their importance in wealth creation at individual level and national level.
- Nurturing leadership potential of student innovators, and entrepreneurs by providing them coordination role to achieve the program objective.



- Program will set foundation for institute's participation in MoE's Innovation and Entrepreneurship initiatives such as IIC, ARIIA, Hackathons, NISP, National Innovation Contest, and YUKTI 2.0 and related programs at MIC and AICTE.

AUC IIC will coordinate with Mentee IICs to create and strengthen the culture of Innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem to promote and supporting students innovations and sustainable start-ups and also instrumental to evolve systems and mechanisms to convert the present demographic dividend into high quality technical human resource capable of doing cutting edge research and innovation and deep-tech entrepreneurship.

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
