
'Online Training on Basic English Grammar' for the residents of Math village and the Office Attendants of AUC by Amity School of Languages



As a part of community service, Amity School of Languages organized an exclusive online training on 'Basic English Grammar' for the residents of Math village and the office attendants of AUC on 20th March 2021 from 5.30 pm to 6.30 pm. The event was conducted by the faculty members of ASL with a view to address the importance of basic English Grammar and communication skills for official purposes.


The training witnessed the enthusiastic participation of Mr. Gobardhan Pal, Mr. Ramcharan Verma, Mr. Ganesh Ram Patel, and many other interested local people from Kharora village. The cooperative interaction between the participants and ASL faculty members was enlivening. Since the participants were of different educational backgrounds, 'Basic English Grammar Lessons' was chosen as the topic of the online training programme. The programme commenced with an introduction to promote inquisitiveness and fervor for proper usage of language with the importance of English in everyday life and how the basic knowledge of English becomes necessary at any place to carry out an official task. In the meeting how the basics of English Grammar can be learnt and adapted in daily communication was discussed. The training focused on how language plays a pivotal role in everyday communication. It was further followed by an interactive practice session wherein the stress was on the importance of usage of Noun and its types in the commonly used phrases in everyday communication. Some basic common phrases used in day-to-day life were discussed. It developed their understanding of the types of nouns and how they can use this as a base to build a connection between the English and Hindi understanding of Basic Grammar. 


ACTIVITY-2




ACTIVITY-3

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Report on Food Distribution Activities in Association with Sparsh.

Amity University Chhattisgarh is association with Sparsh conducted various food distribution camps for the slum and poor people.

Many people can be seen waiting outside the hospitals awaiting the discharge of their relatives undergoing treatment at the hospitals. Their problems have got doubled with the imposition of lockdown by the government as they are not in a position to go anywhere to get food or water. In this situation, Amity University Chhattisgarh conducted many food distribution camps.

Major areas worked on.

A. Assess the potential need for food. Estimate how much food is available in the slum areas and how much more food will be needed to protect the people from possible food shortages.

B. Work with private sector providers and any humanitarian agencies present in the city to secure essential nutritious food stocks for later distribution.

C. Work with various public and private organizations to set up and operate temporary warehouses to receive, store, and distribute the food using social distancing measures.

D. Coordinate with members of the municipal leadership team that are working to identify those most at risk of food insecurity to ensure that the most needy are the people that get food rations first.

Report on Education Activities in Association with Young Foundation

The specific aims of the workshop were to answer primarily two questions:

(1) How can Amity University Chhattisgarh create a framework for youth programs throughout forpromoting awareness of water-related and environmental issues?

(2) How the young generation can use for such a framework and what other tools are necessary toanchor the programme.

Outcome

The outcome was a comprehensive set of ideas that should serve as a basis for the development of new educational and awareness raising projects; furthermore, it could contribute to the formation of a network of involved partners. Such a network of contacts could be invaluable when it comes to asking for support for the educational initiatives and their implementation.

This workshop provides an overview on the main ideas and opinions of the participants in four workshop sessions, during group work and through individual interviews; it also draws overall conclusions reached and highlights potential future steps. Detailed "raw data" is provided in the annex; these include the matrices of the workshop outcomes, transcripts of the interviews, the agendaas well as notes from open discussions.

Topics covered

Topics and key questions elaborated and reflected in four workshop

sessions:Interlinking existing youth programs Key question: Which relevant youth programs are there?

Communication channels of youth and educational initiatives Key question: Which means of communication are relevant for these programs?

Tools that need to be developed for "tapping" youth and educational initiatives started from scratch Key Question: How should Amity University Chhattisgarh be extended/supplemented to find new targets?

Desired tools from the perspective of individual, already existing youth programs and educational initiatives Key Question: Which tools would your organisation use for its youth programs.
