To create awareness about IPR amongst the youth and motivate them to come up with inclusive, transparent and affordable innovations which are beneficial for larger part of society, Amity University Chhattisgarh in association with NRDC organized One Day Workshop on "Innovation and Intellectual Property Rights" on 27th September 2018 for the students, faculty members and researchers. It was a platform to share cutting-edge knowledge, research projects and innovative ideas by domain experts. The workshop aimed at sensitizing faculty and students on understanding key aspects of IPR, protecting one's ideas, patents, trademarks, copyrights and emphasized importance of innovation and its ever increasing role in our lives.

Shri Alok Awasthi, IAS Director, Chhattisgarh Academy of Administration and Managing Director, Chhattisgarh Khadi and Village Industries Board, Dr. W. Selvamurthy, President, ASTIF, Chancellor, AUC, Prof. (Dr.) Shyamalendu Niyogi, Director NRDC-Amity IFC; Advisor RBEF & AHF; Professor Amity University, Noida, Dr Smita Sahu, Assistant Professor, Registered Indian Patent Attorney, ASTIF/ADSI/AIB Amity University Noida, Prof Vijay Singh Dahima, Head of Campus, Prof S C Mukhopadhyay, Registrar inaugurated the workshop.

Dr. Pradeep Kumar Sinha, an engineer turned academician, is the Vice Chancellor and Director of International Institute of Information Technology (IIIT), Naya Raipur. Earlier he was with the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC), where he had led National Programs in areas of Supercomputing, Grid Computing, and Health Informatics.

Dr. Sinha is an educationist, researcher, scientist, inventor, and internationally acclaimed author of computer textbooks. He has significantly contributed to the advancement of Science & Technology and Technical Education. His technical contributions include national projects, supercomputing systems and facilities, healthcare products and solutions, international patents, a number of technical papers and six books in the area of Computer Science & Engineering. On public demand, books authored by him have been translated in local languages like Japanese and Hindi.

However, due to the Covid-19 pandemic situation, the only webinar is permissible with a low budget. Accordingly, Rs.17,000/- is granted to you for conducting 4/more than 4 lectures/events through webinars online as it will be fit to the budget. Excess expenditure than the grant amount will not be paid by ICPR, the same may be taken care of by the organizing institution. Release of the grant is subject to fulfilling the required documents. NGOs, Trusts, Samitis, and similar organizations should provide the Registration Certificate, and if required Audit Report of the organization for release of the grant. Filled in Application format is required, it is not filled up / sent properly.

The Programme should be initiated on the International Day of Yoga.

The organizers are requested to follow the terms and conditions as mentioned below. Separate sanction orders will be issued shortly.

- 1. Conduct of Programmes: The sanctioned amount shall be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned. The Grants will be spent for academic events like Lectures / Series of Lectures programmes Seminars/Colloquia, Round Table Discussion, Discussion groups, Brainstorming Sessions / Quiz Competitions and Practice Competitions between learners/participants and Training programmes - all related to Yoga and its practice in the line, spirit, and objectives of the International Day of Yoga. The segments of the programmes may be conducted on the same day or extended with multiple programmes at a stretch or different days/times with breaks in between. Part of the programmes/ events must be started on the yoga day online and other parts must be conducted within Three Months of the issue of this Sanction Order. It is stressed that all programs preferably are conducted online, and offline programs should be avoided.
- 2. The organizing departments should invite the staff and students of the departments of philosophy of nearby Universities/Colleges and common people who are interested in Philosophy for the International Day of Yoga and related programmes. The events may be conducted in the form of Webinar / Online and no offline event be allowed keeping the Corona Pandemic Guidelines and such restrictions. The organizer may send the soft-copy of Banner, Programmes, and the Links, to seminar.icpr@gmail.com, at least one week before the programme, which may be published in an appropriate social media and groups for wider circulation and participation.
- 3. Expenditure Control: The payee shall exercise a reasonable economy in spending the sanctioned amount. Regular accounts shall be maintained in respect of expenditure of the sanctioned amount. Excess amounts other than the already grant will not be paid from ICPR, and the same may be taken care of by the Organizer / Organizing institution (though all expenditures will be reflected in the report).
- 4. Rs. 2500/- will be the single-time honorarium for the (single) organizer, and for each of the resource persons delivering lecture/training/conducting a segment of the programme. Sh. Ateesh Kumar Singh, Joint Secretary (AFI), M/o MSME and Vice Chairman of the Committee welcomed AS& DC (MSME) who is the Chairman and other members of the committee. Then, he briefed about the scheme and the details of the applications received in My MSME portal from the institutions for approval as Host Institutes under the scheme so that they are eligible to upload the ideas whenever the portal is opened for the same in future. 195 no. of applications received from institutions which were taken up for consideration and approval.

Thereafter, Sh. Vinamra Mishra, Director (T&P) and Member Secretary explained point wise agenda items for the discussion during the meeting.

Sh D. K Singh, AS&DC (MSME)/Chairman, expressed in his initial remarks that during next financial year Regional Committees headed by IITs / IIMs may be formed at the regional level to scrutinize the ideas received from the Host institutes and submit the shortlisted ideas to the PMAC for final approval. It would help in faster short listing of the ideas.

Agenda Item No. 1

Committee approved in principle 147 Institutes as Host Institutes subject to condition that all the requisite documents under the scheme need to be completed by them. These institutes were duly recommended/forwarded by the Implementing Agencies (MSME DI / MSME TC) after due diligence. Every HI is supposed to have its independent status. The funds under the scheme shall be released only in the name of the Host Institute and not to trust or group of institutions. All requisite tax documents and audit reports need to be submitted by them as and when requested by this office.
