'Online Training on Basic English Grammar' for the residents of Math village and the Office Attendants of AUC by Amity School of Languages

Amity University Chhattisgarh has been organizing social outreach programmes since its inception with a view to support and help the society in creating harmony and peace. As a part of community service, Amity School of Languages organized an exclusive online training on 'Basic English Grammar' for the residents of Math village and the office attendants of AUC on 20th March 2021 from 5.30 pm to 6.30 pm. The event was conducted by the faculty members of ASL with a view to address the importance of basic English Grammar and communication skills for official purposes.

The training witnessed the enthusiastic participation of Mr. Gobardhan Pal, Mr. Ramcharan Verma, Mr. Ganesh Ram Patel, and many other interested local people from Kharora village. The cooperative interaction between the participants and ASL faculty members was enlivening. Since the participants were of different educational backgrounds, 'Basic English Grammar Lessons' was chosen as the topic of the online training programme. The programme commenced with an introduction to promote inquisitiveness and fervor for proper usage of language with the importance of English in everyday life and how the basic knowledge of English becomes necessary at any place to carry out an official task. 
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ACTIVITY-2
